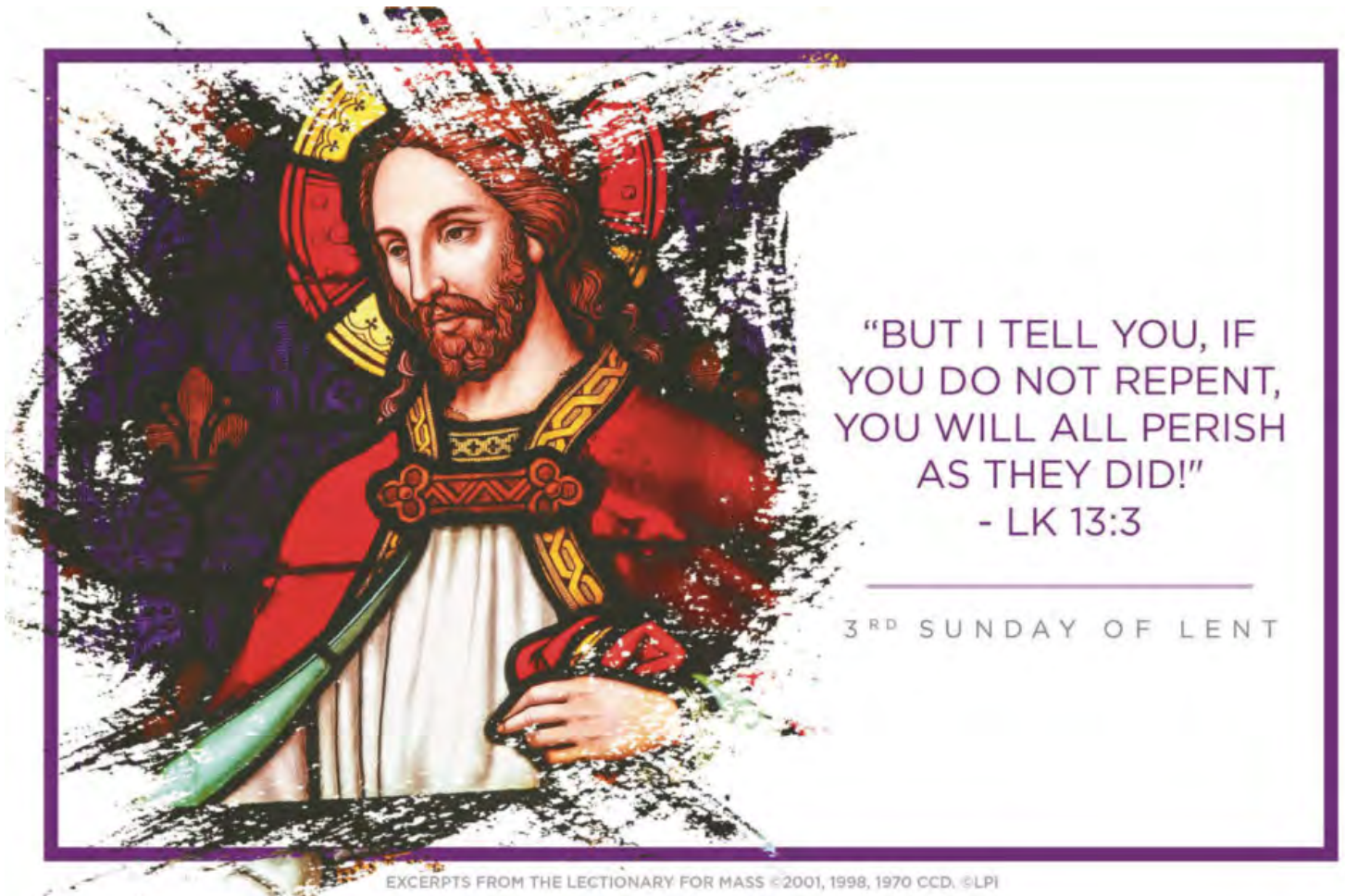

Dear Friends,

A brief report on the **Annual Appeal** before the next reflection on *33 Days to Eucharistic Glory*. As of today (3/18), 291 households have pledged \$216,000 to the Appeal which puts us a little behind last year's figures in both categories. Once again, if you gave last year, please help out this cause again this year and if you've never given, or not given in a number of years, your gift helps the Church of Newark do what every parish is called to be and do—a witness to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, His love for and presence in our world. What better cause could there be, considering the state of our world today. And it helps the parish to do the same thing so please make and complete a pledge as early as possible. Thank you.

Do you have a favorite Saint? Saint Anthony, because you're constantly losing things. St. Francis of Assisi, because you love animals. As I write this, it's the Feast of St. Joseph who is my favorite Saint because he knew how to accept the will of God for his life and because he did it without fanfare. Most of the time, we have a favorite Saint (if we do) because they teach us something about life and how to live it. The next part of his book, Matthew Kelly focuses on 14 saints who teach us something about life. And all of them are grounded in and find their strength from the Eucharist, in its Celebration and in its Adoration. It is best expressed in the words of Pope St. John Paul II. "The Eucharist is the secret of my day. It gives strength and meaning to all my activities of service to the Church and to the whole world. He stays here with us: He is God with us. Seek Him without tiring, welcome Him without reserve, love Him without interruption: today, tomorrow, forever." For all of the saints Kelly identifies, the Eucharist is at the center of their hearts and the center of their lives.

Flowing from their Eucharistic devotion (in the widest sense of that word) each of these saints teach us a lesson about living the Christian life. Mother Teresa saw Christ in every person she met. "Every person is Christ for me, and since there is only one Jesus, the person I am meeting is the one person in the world at that moment." Pope Saint John Paul II lived such a profound spiritual life because he could go to that place deep within himself to encounter the Divine Visitor, an encounter which could only grow through the experience and practice of silence. Saint Therese of Lisieux (the saint we used to call the *Little Flower*) understood that "Our Lord does not look so much at the greatness of our actions, or even their difficulty, as at the love with which we do them." *The Little Way*, which is her calling card, is simply little things done with great love. But love, real love, love that is kind, caring compassionate and gentle, doesn't happen without self-denial and self-sacrifice for the sake of others. St. Maximilian Kolbe taught us that when he gave his life in a Nazi concentration camp for one, and only one, other inmate—not tens, or hundreds or thousands, but only one. This love for others, which both St. Therese and Saint Maximilian lived, flows from our experience of the God Who is Love, as St. Thomas Aquinas extols. "The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Love. It signifies Love. It produces Love. The Eucharist is the

consummation of the whole spiritual life.” To live this is to make the longest journey, the journey from the head to the heart, from knowing about Jesus to knowing Jesus. And when this happens in our hearts, we can surrender to Jesus and His will for us with the trust that Saint Faustina displayed in her famous line, “Jesus, I trust in you,” which makes possible the kind of yes that Mary gave at the Incarnation. After that yes, Mary carried Jesus into the world and her first act carrying Jesus was to rush to Elizabeth in her time of need and bring joy to a waiting world (“and the infant in my womb leaped for joy.” Elizabeth at the visitation).

According to all of these saints, this kind of life only flows from a dedication to the Eucharist.

Do you see that in yourself as you approach the Altar today?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process to guide an inquirer towards a personal relationship with Jesus Christ through the sacraments that are celebrated in the Catholic Church during Easter.

The Elects are non-baptized adults who were enrolled in the Rite of Election to continue their journey to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church—to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist on the Easter Vigil.

These OCIA special rites of the Scrutinies are celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent. These rites are intended to enlighten the Elects on the destructive effects of sin and to reflect on developing a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

The First Scrutiny (this Sunday at 11AM) is on the Gospel of John regarding the Samaritan Woman at the well and her encounter with Jesus. It is to teach the Elects, and everyone, that Christ is the Living Water. The two Elects, Peter Choe and Dariann Zorilla, are invited to the sanctuary to listen to the First Scrutiny prayers and receive the blessings.

The parish community is invited to pray for this Easter 2025 group of catechumens and candidates as they journey to receive their sacraments.

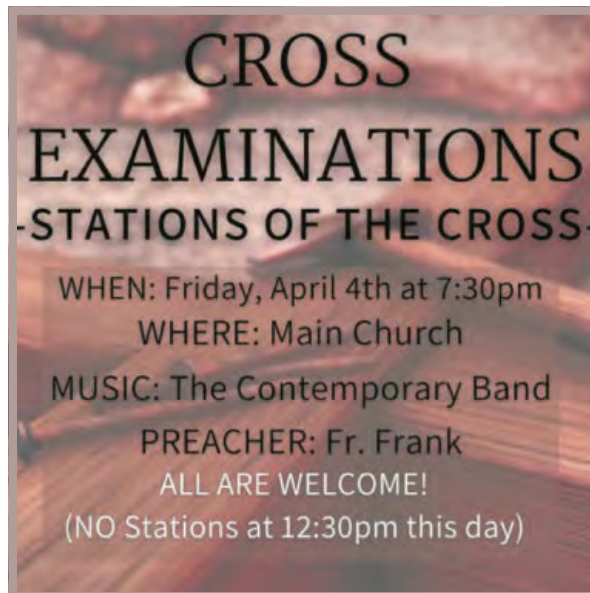

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration (PEA) is the continuous, 'round-the-clock adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the consecrated Eucharist, the true presence of Jesus Christ, in a Church or Chapel. It involves Adorers taking turns, ensuring that someone is always present in prayer before the Eucharist.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration brings many spiritual blessings to individuals, parishes, and communities. Some were outlined in our February 23<sup>rd</sup> bulletin. Below are others.

**Spiritual Renewal of Parishes and Communities:** Parishes with PEA often experience increased Mass attendance and stronger community engagement—increased Confession and other sacraments.

**Healing and Divine Assistance:** Jesus, present in the Eucharist, brings physical, emotional, and spiritual healing. Many have testified to receiving answers to prayers, peace in suffering, and even miraculous interventions.

**Reparation for Sins and Intercession for the World:** Adoration allows us to make reparation for our sins and those of the world. It becomes an opportunity to intercede for others, including the Church, the suffering, and those in need of conversion.

**Strengthening of Faith in the Real Presence:** Spending time in Adoration deepens belief in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It fosters greater reverence and love for the Mass and Holy Communion.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is a source of countless graces, both seen and unseen, as it keeps the presence of Christ at the heart of a community 24/7.

## THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



### TODAY'S READINGS

#### 1. Exodus 3:1-8, 13-15

In this excerpt, God makes Himself known to His chosen servant, Moses. He reveals Himself as (1) the God of Moses' ancestors, Who (2) will deliver their descendants (the Hebrews) from slavery, through (3) Moses, who will be His instrument. Though Moses acknowledges his unworthiness, God, Himself, will be with him as his strength. In response to Moses' question about His identity, God responds with something of an enigma. "He causes to be what comes to be," that the people may know when they are delivered; it is **this God** Who delivers them.

#### 2. 1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12

In attempting to encourage the community to maintain its focus on Christ, Paul often cites examples from Israelite history of that community's failure to maintain fidelity to their Covenant with Yahweh. In today's excerpt, Paul reminds the Corinthians of the miracles Yahweh did for His people, the guidance of the cloud, the passage through the Red Sea, the manna and the water. Yet still they were unfaithful. Christians should learn from them, and maintain their focus on living the life of Christ.

#### 3. Luke 13:1-9

Though neither of these two incidents is attested to by the other Evangelists, Luke cites them as a warning from Jesus that the time for repentance is short and unpredictable. These incidents should occasion a time for personal reflection and personal repentance before it is too late. In the parable of the fig tree, the message is equally clear—we are in that year of grace, that last year given to us to respond to God, and to bear the fruit of faithful commitment and service.

### REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. In announcing Himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, God stirs the memory of Moses to the great things done for them. What things, great or small, has God done for you, in your life?
2. How do you understand God's name as revealed to Moses?
3. This Lent, what can you do in your spiritual life that will bear fruit for the Kingdom?
