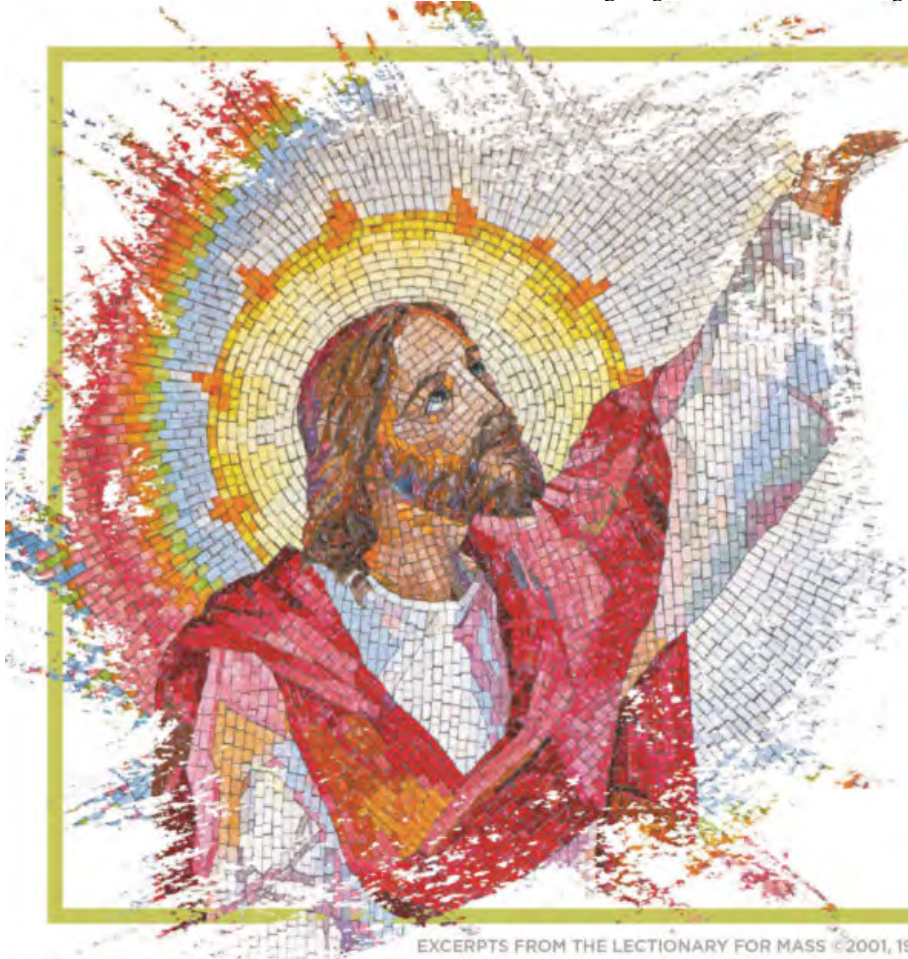

Dear Friends,

Following on the heads' up that I gave you last week, I write today on the **Annual Appeal** of the Archdiocese. I looked back to see the last time I mentioned **The Appeal** in my column. I did a one-liner on March 3 but have not really mentioned **The Appeal** since the bulletin of Feb. 25th. Looking back through those bulletins I realized how long-winded I have become. I promise I will be a lot shorter today.

To briefly summarize, **The Appeal** funds programs for *Proclaiming the Gospel, Passing on the Faith, Caring for the Poor and Vulnerable and Forming Future Priests and Supporting Retired Clergy*. The largest segment of **The Appeal** in terms of dollar support is *The Caring for the Poor and the Vulnerable* and the largest chunk of that money goes to support Catholic Charities. (As I look toward retirement next year, I'm most interested in that support for retired clergy). Each of these segments are vital for the continuation and growth of our Catholic communities. I hope you will all agree that the campaign is a worthy cause and I ask for your help in supporting these works.

There is another reason to pledge and that's because the parish directly benefits from **The Appeal**. Everything over and above our goal is divided between the Archdiocese and the parish, often referred to as the rebate aspect of **The Appeal**. All pledges made before June 30 and paid by December 31st are subject to the rebate formula. Pledges made after June 30 are not. The parish received over \$100,000 in rebates from last year's campaign. Obviously I believe the segments listed above are worthy of support (and I have given a gift to **The Appeal**, as I do every year), but the rebate program, and the support which the parish receives from it, is not chump-change, and helps the parish continue its own programs. In the bulletin of Feb. 18th I shared that we have gotten off to a really good start. Unfortunately, we've slowed down a bit and are now behind last year's campaign at this point in time.

If you've supported **The Appeal** in the past but have not yet done so this year, I ask you to support it again, and before the June 30th deadline. If you have not, help us become a parish of over 500 donors by your support. If you go to the parish website and click on **The Appeal** link, it will take you directly to **The Appeal** website here you can make a gift. Please be sure to identify Our Lady of Mount Carmel-Ridgewood as your parish so we can get the benefit of your gift. If you prefer not to use electronic means and don't have the materials that came in the mail, pledge envelopes are available in the racks at the side entrances and in the rectory.

Thank you for your support. It's greatly appreciated by the Archdiocese and **the parish**.

1. Acts of the Apostles 3:13-15, 17-19

This address follows the healing of a cripple by Peter and John and Peter wants it to be clear that the true source of the healing is Jesus, not them. God's saving work in history has now reached its fulfillment in the glory given to Jesus Christ, whom the people rejected, out of ignorance, in favor of a murderer. But all of this had already been anticipated by their own prophets. This Jesus, who suffered at their hands, has been raised in glory, and if they accept Jesus as Lord, and turn away from their sins, they too will find new life.

2. 1 John 2:1-5a

The proclamation of the salvation message, Jesus suffered, died and rose to save us from our sins, is meant to be followed by the ethical response of obeying God's word so that the love of God is perfected in every believer. This is a major theme of the author of this first letter of John. However, the author is aware of human weakness and reminds his readers that in the case of such a fall, the believer has, in Jesus, an advocate, who stands alongside the sinner, pleading his/her cause. But to claim knowledge of God while repeatedly violating his commandments makes the believer a liar.

3. Luke 24:35-48

While gathered together on the night of the Resurrection, discussing the story of His appearance on the road to Emmaus, this wider audience of His follower's experiences yet another appearance of the Risen Lord. He brings peace into an environment of fear, terror and confusion. To calm their fears, and bring continuity and reality to the moment, He shows them His hands and feet and asks for some food. As on the road to Emmaus, He explains the Scriptures to them, opening their minds to its real meaning and commissioning them to carry on His mission.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have I experienced a time where generous and forgiving love has brought about conversion, transformation and healing?
2. From what have I needed to be converted? Have I been, or is there still this need?
3. What do I believe I have been promised by God? By the Church?
