SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Acts of the Apostles 8:5-8, 14-17

In the closing words of last week's Gospel, Jesus tells His friends, they "will do the works that I do." In this excerpt from **Acts**, Luke tells us of the fulfillment of that promise, as he relates the work of Philip. After the outbreak of the persecution, Philip travels to Samaria, where he preaches and cures and many are baptized. As in other references, Luke stresses the unity of the Church in the action of two Apostles, Peter and John, who go personally to lay hands and confer the Holy Spirit. Philip does not work independently. This Jesus-movement is always the action of those who are in communion with the apostolic witness to the Risen Lord.

2. 1 Peter 3:15-18

Amidst the suffering of the world, the Church must bear witness to hope for the sake of those who struggle. That hope is found in the Risen Lord, and it must be shown not only in the life of the believer but in ongoing conversation and the call to conversion. The author even shows the reader how, not in threats, criticism and fear, but in gentleness and reverence, and even in the suffering that may follow from being a disciple of Him Who suffered before you.

3. John 14:15-21

Having told His disciples that He must leave them, Jesus promises them another (He is the 1st) Advocate, counselor, the teacher Who will bear witness to the truth about Jesus, God and the disciples. That truth is that Jesus and the Father are one and that the disciple can share in this life. How? By obeying Jesus' commandment of love. Knowledge is not enough. It is about practice, behavior and the way one lives one's life. The Advocate will assist the disciple in both knowing and living Jesus' life. While the historical Jesus may be about to depart, the promised Spirit, the Advocate, will remain with the Church until the end of time.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. In the 2nd Reading, St. Peter encourages us to "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for the reason for your hope." Do you have that hope? Do you ever share it with a world in so desperate need for it?
2. What do you do on a daily basis to listen to Jesus' message in your life?
3. When has the Spirit been an Advocate for you in your times of trouble? Has your awareness of God's helpful presence become clearer, deeper, more frequent?

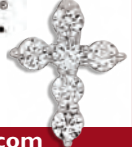
