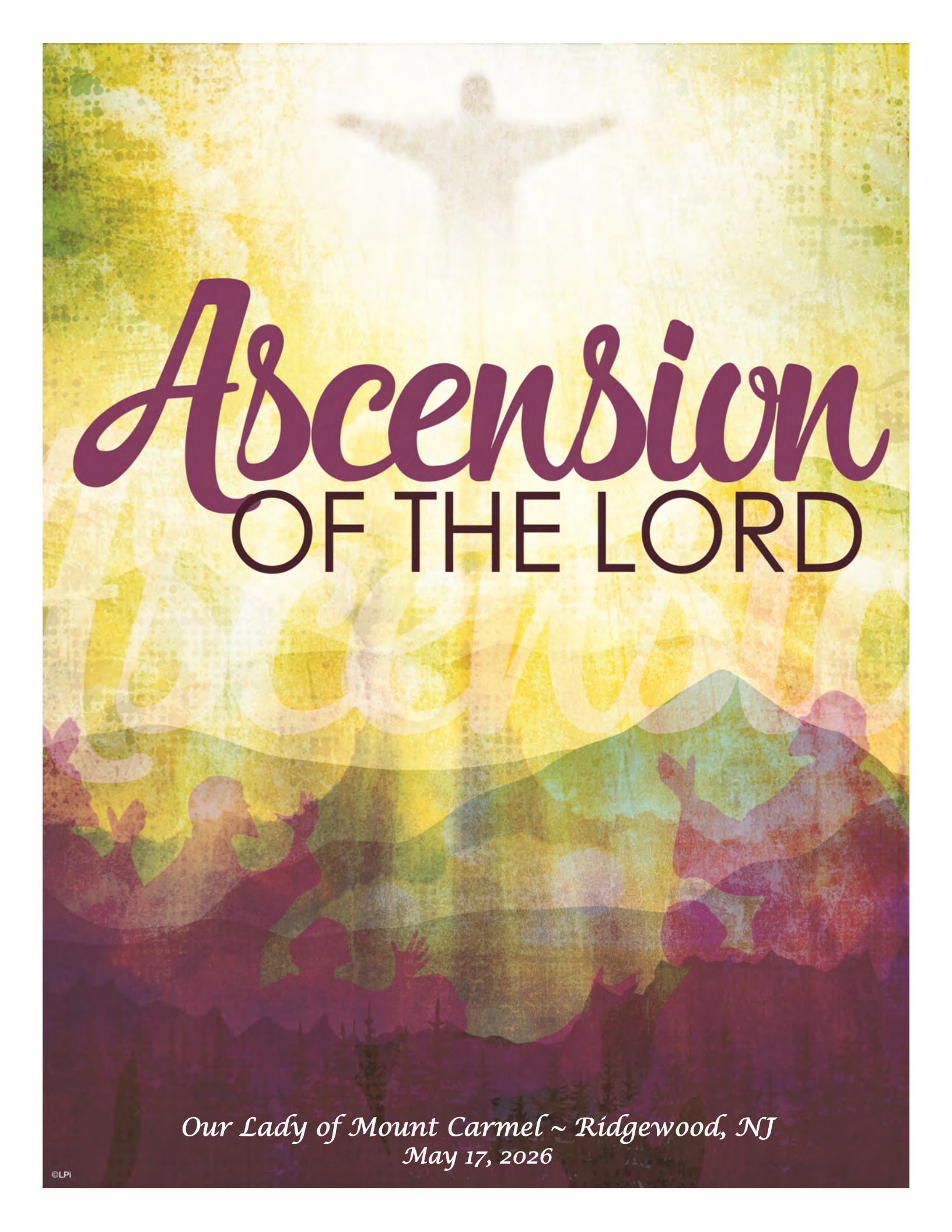

Dear Friends,

I realize I should have written about this last weekend but since I was preparing to be away, it slipped my mind. We celebrate this weekend the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord. On this Sunday and not on Ascension Thursday. Except if you work in New York and went to Mass last Thursday, you celebrated Ascension Thursday. Confused? Yes.

When the American bishops received permission from the Vatican in 1999 to transfer the Ascension from Thursday to Sunday, it was left up to each ecclesiastical province to make that decision. Basically, with a few exceptions because of size, an ecclesiastical province is equal to a state. Thus, the ecclesiastical province of Newark is the State of New Jersey and the ecclesiastical province of New York is the State of New York. Before the pandemic, the only ecclesiastical provinces that maintained the Ascension on Thursday were Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Philadelphia and Omaha. During and after the Pandemic, Newark joined the rest of the country in celebrating Ascension on Sunday while the remaining provinces I mentioned retained the celebration on Thursday. Thus, if you attended Mass in New York last Thursday, the Ascension was celebrated but in New Jersey, right across the river, we're celebrating it today. Just a little Church trivia.

The Church has an ancient tradition of preparing for great feasts by a nine day novena. (The word novena actually comes from a Latin word meaning nine). If you are reading this on line on Friday, this would actually be the day on which the novena in preparation for the Feast of Pentecost would begin. But even if you are reading it on Sunday, I would ask the whole parish to begin eight or nine days of prayers for the Holy Spirit's guidance in the selection of a new pastor for this faith community we call Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Since our parish is dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God, I ask that the prayer you offer be the Rosary, recited each day, beginning today and ending on Pentecost Sunday, that the Holy Spirit guide the powers that be in selecting a new pastor who will shepherd this community in the image of the Good Shepherd. Thank you.

On a much more mundane matter. Please remember the **Annual Appeal** and how it helps the Church of Newark, **and our parish**, in fulfilling the call of Jesus that we hear in today's Gospel, "**Go, therefore, and make disciples.**"

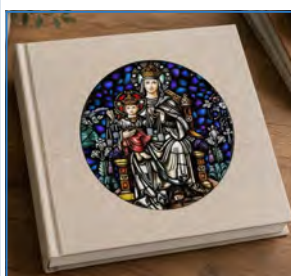

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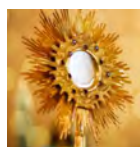

SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

Luke begins his second work with a review of his Gospel account of what Jesus said and did before returning to his heavenly Father. Especially important here is the instruction Jesus gives the apostles, with the Lord's particular emphasis on what his Father's word has revealed about the Kingdom of God and his own mission to bring that Kingdom to fulfillment. Their task is to witness to the Lord and to carry on as his faithful servants, in the power of the Holy Spirit.

2. Ephesians 1:17-23

Paul prays that the heavenly Father gives readers the wisdom to appreciate all the gifts granted them in faith. This Jesus, who had walked among them, has been raised from the dead and is now seated at the right hand of the Father—with authority over all creation.

3. Matthew 28:16-20

Matthew's Gospel does not end with a description of the Ascension. Rather it ends with the Great Commission, on the same mountain where he preached His most famous "Sermon." He acknowledges the power over heaven and earth that has been given to Him and with that power He sends them out to make disciples of all nations, teaching the world (again the great "Sermon") all that Jesus taught. Named Emmanuel (God is with us) at the beginning of this Gospel, Matthew ends with the fulfillment of those words, "I am with you always."

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have you ever felt that Jesus was "commissioning" you for a special work?
2. Paul speaks about "the hope that belongs to his call." Called as a Christian do you live in that hope today?
3. Paul's words in the 2nd Reading evoke a sense of awe and inspiration, "the hope that belongs to his call," "the riches of glory," "the surpassing greatness of his power." Do you feel it when you read those words?

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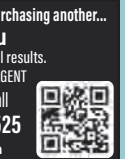
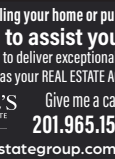
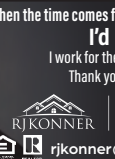
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
