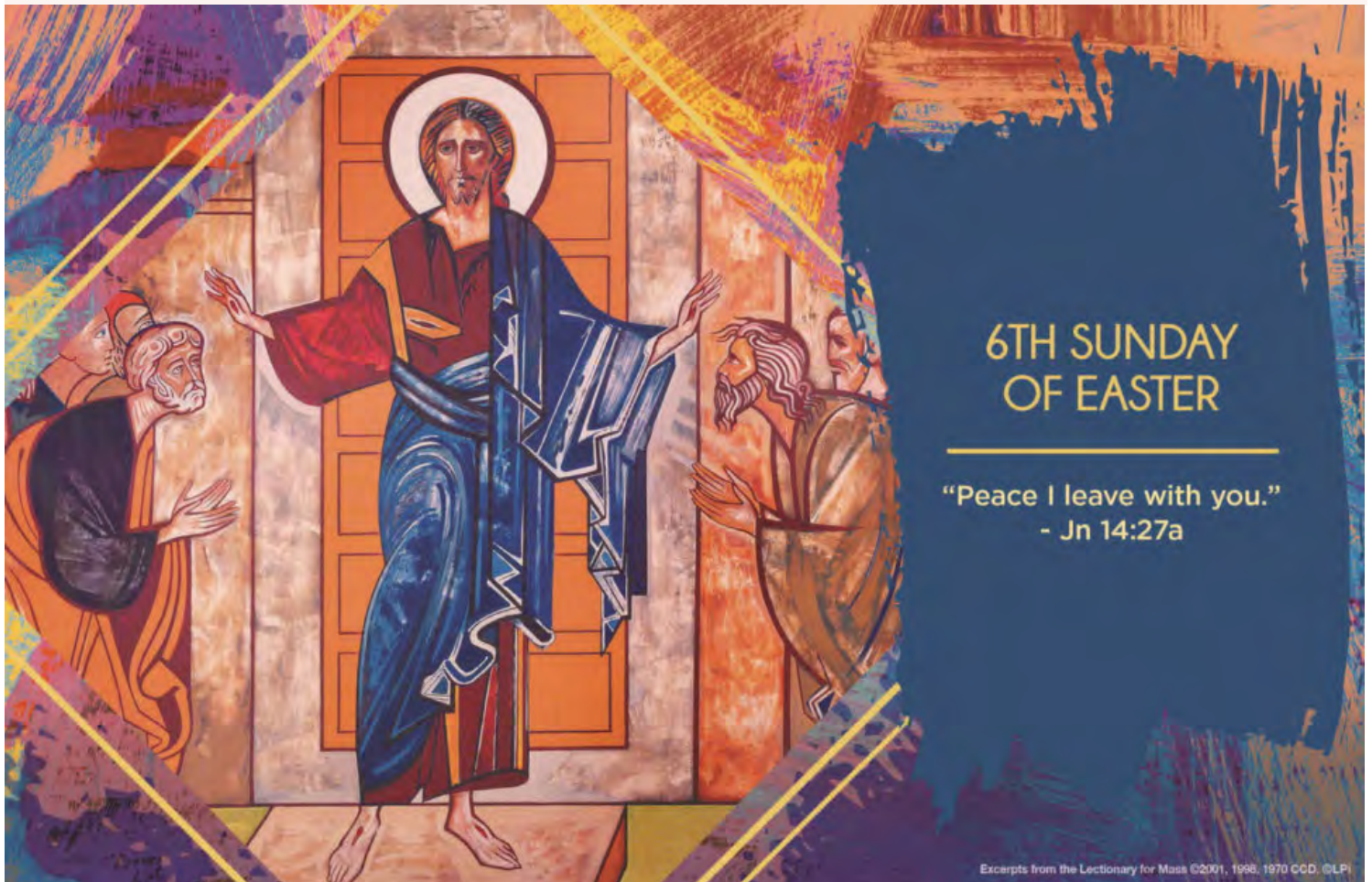

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Dear Friends,

Some repeat concerns that have finite time-lines:

-The Disciple Maker Index (DMI).

We need your input. Every parish in the Archdiocese is now engaged in a planning process to look at ourselves, where are our strengths, where do we need to grow, how are we living as a faith-filled, evangelizing witness to the presence of Jesus Christ in our midst so He can be present in the larger world? The **DMI** is a survey instrument designed to help us answer some of these questions through your eyes. But we need you to take it. As of this writing 1059 parishioners have already answered. But it's open to every parishioner, 16 years of age and older. And time is running out—today, May 25th, is the last opportunity. Please help by taking the survey. Here is the QR code and the URL to take you right to it. Or you can get a paper copy at the rectory—but only today. Join the more than a thousand fellow parishioners in making our parish a better community by helping us grow in response to this survey.

-The Annual Appeal. As the **DMI** will help us grow as disciples (hopefully), your participation in the **Annual Appeal** will help provide the resources for the parish to do that with the rebate we receive from the Archdiocese on contributions over our goal. But to qualify for the rebate those pledges must be received by June 30, 2025, even though they need not be paid off until December 31, 2025. We are almost at the end of May so please join the 417 other parish households in contributing to the **Appeal**. (At the same time last year, there were 437 households who had committed to the **Appeal**.) Your support will also help the Archdiocese fulfill its own calling to witness to Christ, to help form disciples, to pass on the faith and to care for the needs of the poor. Please make a pledge today. Go to the link on the homepage of the parish website and be sure to select *Our Lady of Mount Carmel—Ridgewood*, from the drop-down menu.

-The Priests' Convocation. The Convocation (Convention), itself, is not the concern. It will be a great time for prayer and reflection for all the diocesan clergy who serve in this local Church of Newark. The concern is that the three of us will be away from the parish at the same time. We leave on Memorial Day and return Thursday afternoon. You will find the Communion Service Schedule on Page 3 in this bulletin, as well as the schedule of Masses in the neighboring parishes. I asked last week that you pray for the priests, that this Convocation may be a significant spiritual moment in our lives. I also ask that you pray for the parish, that it be a quiet, uneventful three days.

Lastly, but not a matter of concern, just a reminder. The

nation pauses on Monday to observe Memorial Day, to remember all those who lost their lives in defense of the freedoms we all enjoy as citizens of this country. Be sure to take the time on Monday to remember the reason for the holiday. Join us at Mass at 8:30AM to remember them in prayer or at the Memorial in Van Neste Square Park at 11:00AM for the Veteran's observance. In addition to its observance, may it be a great celebration of family ties for you and those you love.

CARDINAL TOBIN ORDAINS NEW DEACONS



The Diaconate is the ministry of service in the Catholic Church. Diakonia is Diaconate in Greek and it is to serve. This ministry started with the apostles inviting seven worthy men to help them spread the Good News of Jesus Christ to all.

Deacons assist at Mass, proclaim the Gospel, preach, do baptisms, preside at funeral wake services, and many other sacramental duties in the service of our Lord. **Permanent Deacons** can remain married prior to their ordination. Many of them work in various professions, businesses, government agencies, and many areas of society. They do not get ordained as priests. **Transitional Deacons** are seminarians who have finished their theological studies and get assigned in parishes. After about a year, they will be ordained as priests and will be assigned for several years in a parish.

The Archdiocese of Newark welcomed 27 Catholic men to the diaconate ministry. The Archbishop of Newark, Cardinal Joseph Tobin, proudly and joyfully ordained 19 permanent deacons and 8 transitional deacons on Sunday, May 18, 2025 at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart Cathedral. It is a time of celebration in the Catholic Church to have these faithful newly ordained deacons serve various parishes. Please pray for them.

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Acts of the Apostles 15:1-2, 22-29

In this excerpt, the first major attempt to resolve a growing dispute with the Christian community is brought to a council of the apostles and elders, convened in Jerusalem. At issue is the role of the Mosaic Law in the lives of those who have come to believe in Jesus. Is the traditional sign of the covenant between Abraham and God required? Relaying on the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, the council guides the church through this difficult moment, affirming that salvation comes through faith in Jesus Christ, but certain practices which are in opposition to that should be avoided.

2. Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

As in previous texts, the author seeks to lift the spirits of those suffering under the persecution of the Emperor Domitian. This time he does focus on the eternal city, the New Jerusalem, entered only through the gates of death. Intended to instill hope, the vision of the beyond affirms its universal character, symbolized by the twelve gates (the twelve tribes of Israel and thus, the Old Testament) and the twelve courses of foundation stones (the twelve apostles and thus, the New Testament). No church buildings are needed (no temple) in this city for God, Himself (Jesus—God and the Lamb) is present as the temple. God is also its warmth and light.

3. John 14:23-29

Discipleship is not about theory. Nor is it about just listening, hearing or contemplating. It is about “doing,” putting the word into practice. But the disciples will not be left on their own to accomplish this. The Advocate will come to teach, to remind, to strengthen and to protect them as they carry on the work of Jesus, Who will also give them His peace, a peace which flows from their being incorporated into the relationship between Jesus and the Father.

1. Have you ever felt Jesus “make His dwelling with you”? Explain
2. Have you ever experienced the support and guidance of the Holy Spirit in your life?
3. Have you experienced in your life the difference between the peace that Jesus gives and the peace the world gives?
