Dear Friends,

More thoughts that run through an idle mind

-Do you want to help the parish? You can, by making a pledge to the **Annual Appeal**. Could you do \$100? Or, \$200? Pledge \$16.66 or \$33.33 a month for the next six months? The rebate the parish gets on that pledge would be a great help in maintaining the level of programming the parish now offers to live the Gospel. But the pledge needs to be made before June 30th to qualify for the rebate. Please, give it some thought **and prayer**.

-This is Memorial Day weekend, the “unofficial” beginning of summer. But Memorial Day itself is a day to remember all who have gone before us and **gave their lives** so that we could enjoy the blessings of freedoms under which we live and sometimes take for granted. Stop sometime on Memorial Day and give thanks for them and say a prayer of thanksgiving for them. Or come to the Memorial Day mass at 8:30 on Monday which will be offered for them or attend the service on Monday at 11:00AM at the monument at Van Neste Square Park.

-Fr. Robert Burkot, ordained on Saturday, will be celebrating his 1st Mass here on Sunday of this weekend at 12:30. Fr. Robert came to us a year ago as Deacon Robert. In the last year of their formation, deacons spend their time in parishes, a sort of an internship. While exercising ministry in light of their office, baptizing, preaching, leading prayer, it is expected that they would learn about parish life and the expectations placed on ordained ministers. Fr. Robert has been doing all of that. He has preached, he has baptized, he has led prayer services at wakes and in cemeteries. But he has also visited and brought communion to the sick and the homebound, a ministry he has been very dedicated to. He has catechized the young, especially in our Jr. High Youth Ministry program and prepared one of our special needs children for 1st Holy Communion. He has stood with the priests at the doors of the church before and after all the masses. He did marvelous research into the history of Mount Carmel, culminating in an enlightening presentation of that history a couple of weeks ago. In so many ways, he has shared in the life of this community as if he were staying longer but we always knew he would be moving on after ordination. As I congratulate him on his ordination, I thank him for all the ways he came to serve, and not be served. If you can, please join us in celebrating with him at his 1st Mass and the reception to follow.

-Speaking of leaving, I regret to tell you that Msgr. Sheeran will be leaving us as a Sunday celebrant in the middle of June. Msgr. Sheeran first celebrated Mass here on Dec. 1, 2019, the 1st Sunday of Advent. With Covid it was hard for me to remember that he has been here that long. He has added a great deal to our spiritual life, by his insightful homilies and by the exegesis (explanation of the Scriptural text) he gives before each reading. He will be going to a one-priest parish where he will be able to assist the pastor who

has been carrying the burden of four liturgies every weekend. We wish him well. If you see him over the next couple of Sundays be sure to thank him for his dedication as a priest, for his years of service to Mount Carmel and offer him your prayers for his continued ministry for the Lord and with His people.

-When the Cardinal directed the return to receiving under both kinds (the consecrated bread, the host, and the consecrated wine, the Precious Blood), he set a window for that implementation. It could be no sooner than Holy Thursday and no later than Pentecost. Since this is Pentecost Sunday, if all goes well we will return to the option of receiving from the cup at all the masses this weekend. By "all goes well," I mean that after a hiatus of more than three years, there are bound to be glitches. But I just want to remind everyone that the practice is wholly an option, a decision to be made by the communicant. Catholic theology teaches us that Christ is fully present in either form. Be assured, after a congregant receives from the cup, the minister will wipe it, both inside and out and turn it before it's offered to the next communicant.

Happy Memorial Day and may the summer which "unofficially" begins this weekend be a time of great rest and relaxation for all of us. And fun too.

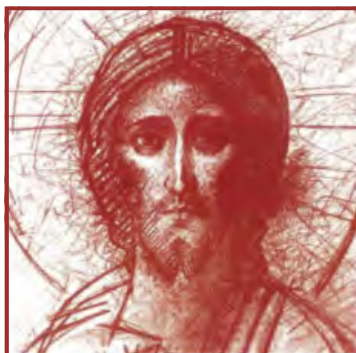

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11

Luke's account of the beginning of the Church's mission is filled with symbols and connections. Wind and fire are mysterious forces, coming and going only by God's design. The wind, especially, recalls the powerful wind of Genesis, sweeping over the waters of creation. The fifty days of Pentecost (Greek for fifty) recalls the fifty days of the Hebrews' experience from the Exodus until the giving of the Law on Sinai. For this new people, created by God's work, the presence of the Spirit enlightens and enlivens it to serve and to witness to all that God did, in and through Jesus, the Christ, breaking down all boundaries and resistance.

2. 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

Attend the Spirit so as to do and be and speak and serve and pray in accord with the Spirit's wise bidding. The Spirit comes as a gift of the Father and the Son and enables the believer to confess faith and put it into action, for the Spirit is the giver of all gifts that build up the Body of Christ, and the source of the unity that brings all these gifts together for the good of that Body.

3. John 20:19-23.

Appearing to a troubled, doubtful and fearful group of followers, Jesus breathes on them a Spirit of peace that prompts a ministry of forgiveness and healing. A death that should have been avenged (in the normal way of thinking) is now to be celebrated by the power of the Spirit Who would give them the strength and courage to do so. Just as Jesus has been sent, so now He sends them, and not just them, but all believers. There is no longer reason to be frightened or doubtful. The risen Jesus and His Spirit will go with them.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. When have I most deeply felt the power of the Holy Spirit in my life?
2. What are the particular gifts, forms of service, abilities I've received and do I offer them to the Church?
3. In what ways am I sent? How do I witness to my faith? Have I been a source of faith-filled hope these last fifteen months?
