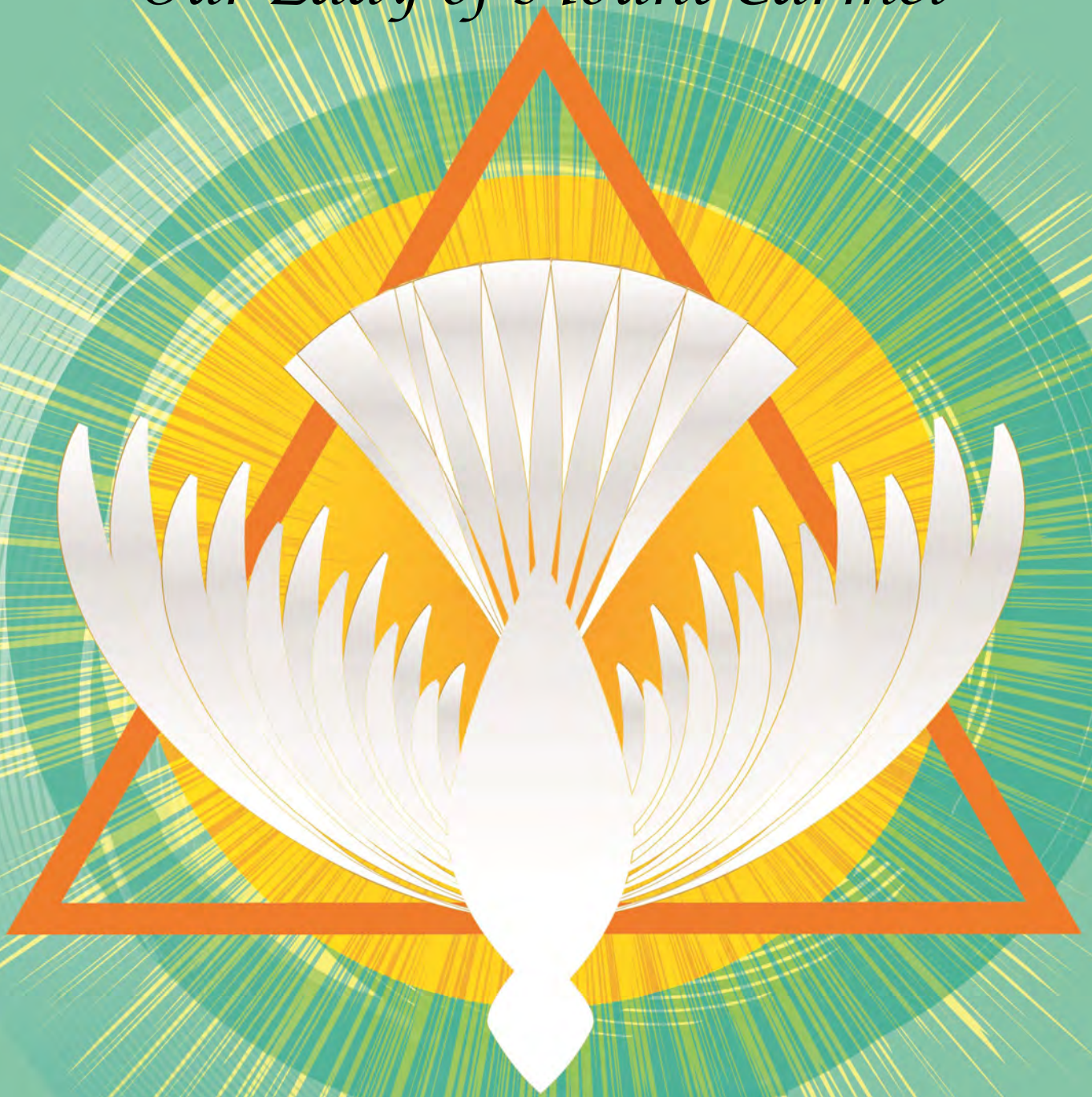

Dear Friends,

This past Saturday, 79 of our teenagers received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Next Friday the rest, 75 more, will be confirmed. I will write more about it next week but please keep all of them in your prayers.

As I write this, I know that Monday is June 1st, a busy month for all of us. I write to remind everyone that it's a critical month for the **Annual Appeal**. The parish is already eligible for the rebate program. But the amount of the rebate will be based on the pledges made by June 30th and paid by December 31st. So, even if you pay off a pledge by Dec. 31st, if the pledge was made after June 30, your gift is not eligible for a rebate to the parish. Last year, the parish received a rebate of \$116,000. That's a considerable "chunk of change" to assist the parish budget. As of today, 419 households have pledged to the campaign. Our final number last year was 542 households. For all who have not pledged, please consider a pledge before June 30th to help the parish continue its vital ministries.

Obviously, the month of June will be a special time for me. People have asked me over these last weeks "how many days to go," and my response has always been that I still have too much on my plate to start thinking about that. But I do know the clock is ticking. The second question that is always asked is where will I be living and what will I be doing. Now that we're almost in June I can share that with you. I will be moving to Saddle River, to the rectory at St. Gabriel's, and offering whatever I can to help Fr. Frank who is all alone. I'm not exactly sure what the nature of that will be like, but I'm not ready to spend the rest of my life sitting on my deck in Pennsylvania watching people float down the Delaware with a G & T in my hand. I still hope to be able to serve the Lord, His Gospel and His Church, in some way, in the time left that He has given me, in places where there is a need, for as long as I can. I'm sure I will have more to say in the coming weeks.

But, be assured of one thing—Mount Carmel will always be home.

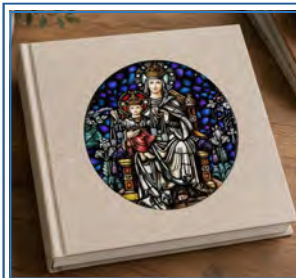

1. Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9

Moses ascends Mount Sinai for a fourth time, after the people had fashioned the golden calf and their apostasy had brought God's wrath down upon them. Notwithstanding this infidelity, God does not cease to love and care for Moses and the people he leads. God welcomes him yet again and listens as he pleads for the people, stiff necked and weak as they are. As God is revealed as Lord, both merciful and gracious, slow to anger and rich in kindness, Moses asks Him to come along on their journey and make them His own.

2. 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

The excerpted text constitutes the conclusion of this letter. While he has pointed out their failures and exhorted them to mend their ways, he encourages them to rejoice, living in peace with one another so that the God of peace and love will be with them. Paul concludes with a goodbye blessing using the Trinitarian formula that would be developed by later theologians as the basic understanding of the nature of God.

3. John 3:16-18

A full-fledged, systematic development of the doctrine of the Trinity is not found in the New Testament. However, major ingredients of that doctrine can be found scattered in the Gospels, especially the Gospel of John. The excerpted passage begins with a bold affirmation that the Son is a gift of the Father, given in absolute freedom because of the Father's love for the world. Those who freely respond, accepting in faith the Son as the Father's gift will be saved and find eternal life.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Where have you found the "grace of our Lord Jesus Christ" in your life this past week?
2. Can you honestly say that God's love for the world ("God so loved the world," John 3:16) influences the way you look at the world, people, contemporary challenges, problems and solutions?
3. What has the "fellowship of the Holy Spirit" done for you or where has it lead you this week?

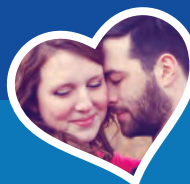
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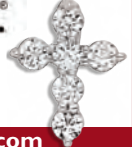
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
