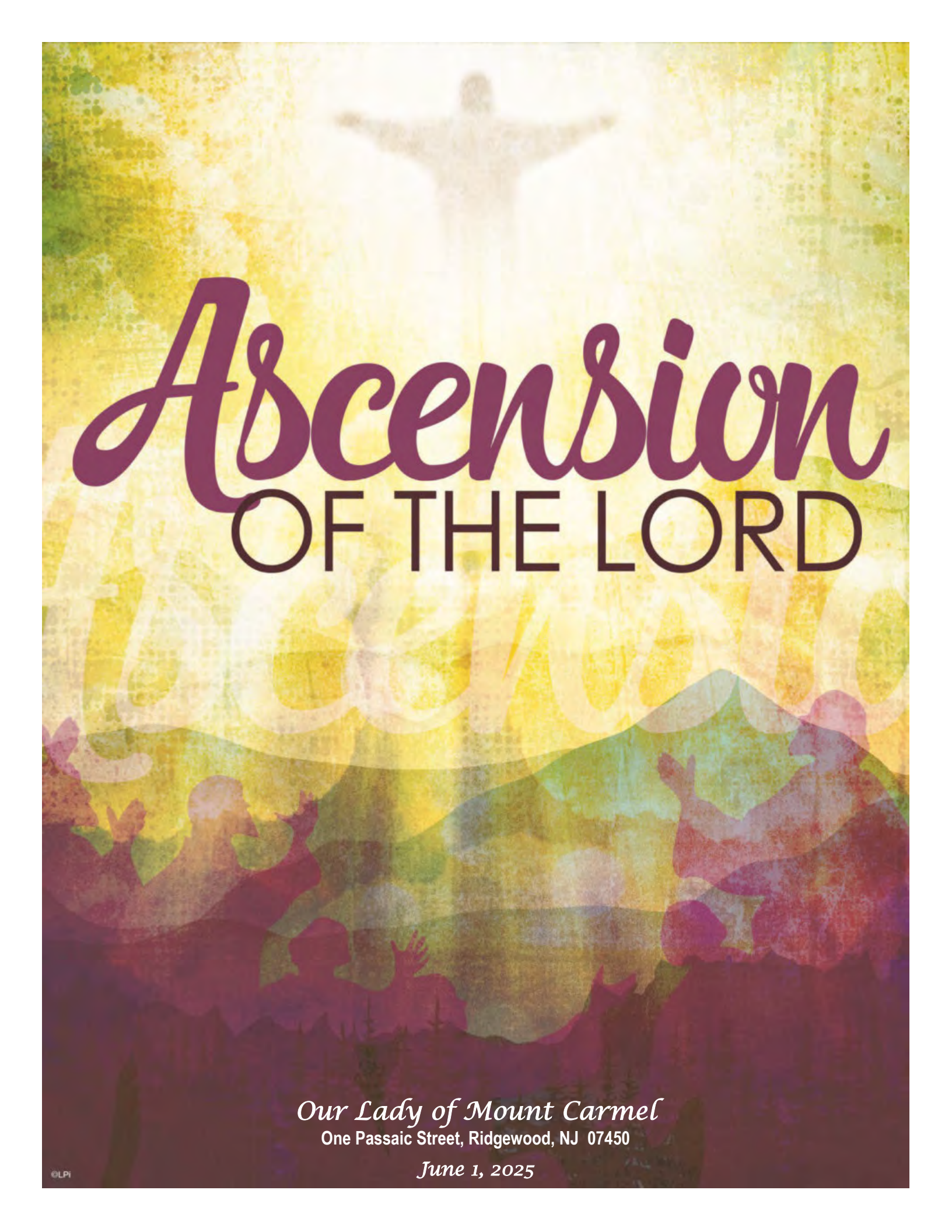

CARDINAL TOBIN ORDAINS NEW DEACONS



The Diaconate is the ministry of service in the
Catholic Church. Diakonia is Diaconate in Greek
and it is to serve. This ministry started with the apostles
inviting seven worthy men to help them spread the Good News
of Jesus Christ to all.

Deacons assist at Mass, proclaim the Gospel, preach, do
baptisms, preside at funeral wake services, and many other
sacramental duties in the service of our Lord. **Permanent
Deacons** can remain married prior to their ordination. Many of
them work in various professions, businesses, government
agencies, and many areas of society. They do not get ordained
as priests. **Transitional Deacons** are seminarians who have
finished their theological studies and get assigned in parishes.
After about a year, they will be ordained as priests and will be
assigned for several years in a parish.

The Archdiocese of Newark welcomed 27 Catholic men to the
diaconate ministry. The Archbishop of Newark, Cardinal
Joseph Tobin, proudly and joyfully ordained 19 permanent
deacons and 8 transitional deacons on Sunday, May 18, 2025
at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart Cathedral. It is a time of
celebration in the Catholic Church to have these faithful newly
ordained deacons serve various parishes. Please pray for them.

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

Luke begins his second work with a review of his Gospel account of what Jesus said and did before returning to his heavenly Father. Especially important here is the instruction Jesus gives the apostles, with the Lord's particular emphasis on what his Father's word has revealed about the Kingdom of God and his own mission to bring that Kingdom to fulfillment. Their task is to witness to the Lord and to carry on as his faithful servants, in the power of the Holy Spirit.

2. Ephesians 1:17-23

Paul prays that the heavenly Father gives readers the wisdom to appreciate all the gifts granted them in faith. This Jesus, who had walked among them, has been raised from the dead and is now seated at the right hand of the Father—with authority over all creation.

3. Luke 24:46-53

Luke presupposes that the reader of his Gospel knows that his story about Jesus will be continued in his second volume in the "Acts of the Apostles," which will unfold the story of the developing Church, but begins by repeating the account of the Ascension. As the central theme of the post-resurrection appearances, Jesus reminds his disciples of the necessity for the Messiah to suffer and die and to be raised up. As witness to this, they are commissioned to preach this to the nations for the forgiveness of sin, and will be confirmed in this preaching by the power of the Holy Spirit. The actual event of the Ascension is narrated very briefly. Jesus raised his hands, blesses his disciples and is taken up. They returned to Jerusalem with joy, to await the promise of the Spirit.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have you ever felt that Jesus was "commissioning" you for a special work?
2. Paul speaks about "the hope that belongs to his call." Called as a Christian do you live in that hope today?
3. Do you feel in your heart the same joy in living the Gospel as the disciples did? Why? Why not?
