1. Proverbs 8:22-31

This book, from those dubbed Wisdom Literature, is traditionally associated with King Solomon. The introductory chapters, from which today's excerpt is taken, prepare the reader to recognize the great spiritual value of the rest of the book. This excerpt presents us with a kind of biography of wisdom; the close associate of God in the creation of the earth, and it was wisdom, working with God, which established the order of the universe, an order which sustains life.

2. Romans 5:1-5

God has forever altered the human condition by setting us in a right relation with God and with one another. We are now at peace with God and have access to grace and the gifts of peace, hope and love are already present with this community of faith. Overwhelmed by this love God has shown us, we are able to struggle successfully with the trials of life.

3. John 16:12-15

Chapter 16 of the Gospel of John, from which this excerpt is taken, contains the Farewell Discourse of Jesus at the Last Supper and, as such, is his explanation to them of how they are to carry on His work when He is no longer bodily with them. And it is the Spirit that is the connecting link between the earthly Jesus and the life of the community. The Spirit will guide the community according to the teachings of Jesus. While the New Testament contains no mature or detailed doctrine of the Trinity, John's Gospel serves as the foundation, in explaining the interrelationship between Father, Son and Spirit, acknowledging both divine mutuality and distinction.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Am I aware of the sacredness of my life to God and the Trinity's dreams for my salvation?
2. Paul says we "stand in grace." When do I most feel God's grace? Can I create more "standing room" for God's grace in my life? How?
3. Whenever we love, we are at one with the Holy Spirit, the One who has poured the love of God into our hearts. How can I better make what I do an offering of love to God?
