What Makes a Dad?

God took the strength of a mountain,

Happy Father's Day to all our parish dads. In appreciation, but out of the usual, the parish has two gifts for you. As usual, there are the pens (so you can keep writing those checks. (Oops! You probably pay electronically through WeShare these days.) Out of the usual, the parish is offering a book of daily (for 30 days) reflections on St. Joseph by Pope Francis called *Walking With Saint Joseph*. During one of our staff meetings, part of the sharing was on our favorite saints. For decades, and I mean decades, no matter what other (new) saint came along, my favorite saint has been St. Joseph. To quote the back cover of the little book, "who better to imitate than this quiet man who knew what it was like to have his life turned upside down and yet faced troubling times with courage and self-sacrificing love—just as we are called to do today." I hope this gift inspires the fathers of our parish in their vocation as Christian fathers. We cleaned the publisher out so I ask if only the fathers take one as we may very well run out. Once again, Happy Father's Day.

And speaking of fathers, the Cardinal has blessed Mount Carmel with the assignment of a 3rd priest to serve the pastoral needs of our very large community, Rev. Rolando Yadao. (Who says the Archdiocese doesn't care about us?) Fr. Yadao was ordained with Fr. Frank and Fr. Kevin in 2011 and after a brief assignment at St. Theresa's in Summit, has spent the last decade at Immaculate Conception in Secaucus. His assignment begins July 1 and I have asked him to write a column about himself so you

can get to know him even before he arrives. And don't worry—no one is leaving.

During Advent 2024, they'll share their travels to 24 different U.S. states! During Advent 2025 they'll share their travels to 24 different countries!

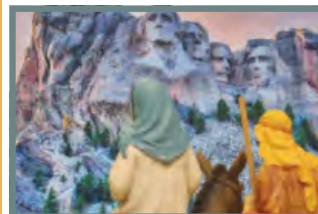

1. **Ezekiel 17:22-24**

Many of Ezekiel's oracles were addressed to the people in the difficult years leading up to the complete collapse of the Kingdom. Instead of seeking security in alliances with pagan kingdoms, God, through Ezekiel, urges His people to turn again to Him, the only true source of security. In today's excerpted passage, the prophet builds on images he has already used, the eagle, the cedar and the vine. At some future date, God will take a tender shoot, plant it and help it grow into a mighty tree.

2. **2 Corinthians 5:6-10**

Paul sees life on earth as being away from the Lord. Because of this, it takes the courage of faith to remain loyal to the Gospel in the midst of life's many difficulties. In spite of life's difficulties, Paul's faith helps him to look forward to eternal life with the glorified Jesus, whom he seeks to please so that his appearance before the judgment seat will be a happy one.

3. **Mark 4:26-34**

Mark has an affinity with seed parables which speak of the nature and reality of the kingdom of God. Generally they are used to emphasize the relationship between the preaching of the word of God and the growth of the Kingdom. In today's excerpted passage, the first parable highlights the mysterious nature of the growth of the seed until it is ripe for the harvest. So it is also with the kingdom. The sower (preacher) may sow, but it is God who makes it grow. In the second parable, Jesus clearly teaches that the Kingdom is not found in the powerful, spectacular or grand, but in the ordinary, mundane and commonplace of life.

1. What seed of God's Word is firmly planted in your heart and significant in your daily life?
2. What seed of God's Word needs greater nurturing in your life?
3. What seed of God's Word helped you through some difficult time or crisis?
