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Dear Friends,

A word of the spiritual nature,

Before the Church turns to the weekly application of how to live the truths (called *Ordinary Time*) we've been celebrating these past four months, Lent, Easter, Ascension, Pentecost, we celebrate two special feasts, The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, last Sunday and the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord, this Sunday. I used to ask myself why—were there too many weeks in the Church calendar, did the Church need some fill-in weeks to make it all work out?

Actually the celebration of these two solemnities gives us an important clue into our life with God. It takes all the bits and pieces of information we have been reflecting on and puts them together. The Trinity celebration sums up everything God has revealed about Himself. Our God is relational, Father, Son and Spirit. And the essence of that relationship is **LOVE**. As St. Augustine explains it, it is much like our experience of human love, the lover (the Father), the beloved (the Son), and the bond of love created (the Spirit). God exists for all eternity in this relationship. And this God is so animated as LOVE that it spills outside of Himself to create a world which can share in it and humankind, created in the "image and likeness" of this LOVE-GOD is invited into the relationship itself. But humankind fails to grasp the enormity of this invitation and sins, and remains outside of Him. And so the Son becomes enfleshed, to bring us back in a self-giving that both mirrors the relationship (this is God) and invites us in, the sacrifice of the Cross. And to accomplish this in us, this GOD-LOVE sends the Spirit to help us enter into the life of God. The celebration of the Trinity, in one feast, reminds us of this spiritual journey we are on, to find our way back into the life of God. Our faith, and our spiritual life is nothing less than this.

Today we celebrate the singularly most powerful way to enter into that life of God—the gift of the Body and Blood of the Son. In this gift we enter into God's life in the reception of the Son who becomes part of us and we become part of Him. And this life of God transforms us (slowly to be sure because of our own human weakness) more and more into the creation God had in mind from the beginning. That is why the Church calls the Eucharist the source (God's life) and the Summit (the end to which we are called) of the Church's life.

With these two feasts, back to back, as it were, the Church sets us off on the journey, the road of living our lives every day as witnesses to the GOD-LOVE to bring that love to a world that can be dark, conflicted, confused and struggling. So now, we are ready, refreshed, strengthened to be what God is—GOD-LOVE in and for the world.

1. Genesis 14:18-20

Through God's help, Abraham has just defeated an enemy that proves invincible to many others. On his return from this victory, he is met by Melchizedek, the priest/king of Salem (Jerusalem), who, in gratitude, prepares a meal for him, to symbolize their special bond. Melchizedek utters words of blessings, to God and to Abraham. Abraham, for his part, offers a tenth of everything to Melchizedek (as priest and representative of God) in gratitude to God for his victory. This priesthood, and its connection to Jerusalem, is fully realized in Jesus, the new and eternal high priest.

2. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Paul reminds the community at Corinth that it is at Eucharist where they would be nearest to Christ and to one another. And this is by God's design. Citing what was handed on to him, he now hands it on to them, that the reality of Jesus' Presence is intimately connected to the reality of His offering. By repeating this ritual the Christian community proclaims this sacrifice until Jesus comes again.

3. Luke 9:11-17

The scene is familiar, a large crowd, distance from both food and shelter, clueless disciples, Jesus Who both cares and teaches. Jesus takes the initiative, after the disciples' initial hesitation. He feeds the hungry and, in doing so, teaches about the kingdom (those who hunger will be filled), about discipleship (only after one offers who one is and what one has can one be used by the Lord to carry on His work), about Who Jesus is (the Son, Who will feed all who come to Him).

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. What impact does the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist have on your life outside the worship setting and the Sunday obligation? Has your understanding of the Eucharist grown since your First Holy Communion? How?
2. Do you share with others, especially those Catholics who have grown lax in practicing Sunday worship, what the Eucharist means to you?
3. How will you witness to Jesus both in your actions and with your words as you live this day with your family?
