How Do We Spend Our Holy Hour?

There is no set rule for spending a Holy Hour before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The most important thing is simply to be with Him. However, the following guide may help:

First 15 Minutes—Be Still

Relax, quiet your mind, and rest in His presence. As Scripture says, *“Be still and know that I am God.”* Allow yourself to slow down and become aware that Jesus is truly present before you.

Second 15 Minutes—Speak with Jesus

Talk to Jesus as you would to a close friend. Share your joys and sorrows, your worries, your desires, and your needs. You may also pray the Holy Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, or other favorite prayers.

Third 15 Minutes—Listen to Jesus

Spend this time in silence. Let Jesus gaze upon you and speak to your heart. Listen quietly and allow His peace and love to fill you.

Last 15 Minutes—Receive and Reflect

Ask Jesus for a virtue or grace that you need most—patience, wisdom, humility, courage, perseverance, or trust. Reflect on how you can live that virtue in your daily life. Let this be your takeaway from your Holy Hour.

Remember, the purpose of a Holy Hour is not to do many things, but simply to spend time with Jesus, who loves you and desires to be with you.

Come and spend an hour FOR and WITH JESUS. He will take care of the rest—our family, our livelihood, our relationships, our health. God is never outdone in generosity.

Our goal is to have two Scheduled Adorers every hour and to fill all 24 hours with an Hour Coordinator.

1. Kings 4:8-11, 14-16

Throughout the Elijah and Elisha cycle of stories as preserved in 1 and 2 Kings, the man of God is featured as speaking God's word, which is ultimately and invariably fulfilled. In today's excerpt, the child promised by Elisha to the woman from Shunem appears to be a reward for her gracious hospitality to the prophet. In fact, the son is given in acknowledgement of her faith in the holy man's purpose in speaking God's word.

2. Romans 6:3-4, 8-11

Baptism is the sacramental event whereby believers encounter and are welcomed into the life of Christ and the Church. Believers are baptized *into* Christ, thus beginning the lifelong process of becoming alive for God in Christ Jesus. The baptized become, as Jesus is, dead to sin, and freed of all the debts that have been satisfied by the death of Christ.

3. Matthew 10:37-42

Great detachment (even over family) will be needed to make Jesus a priority in the life of the disciple. Even greater courage and humility will be needed for taking up one's cross and following Jesus' lead in suffering and death. Just as Jesus willingly accepted God's inscrutable ways and embraced this suffering that came into his life, so must those who believe in Him accept the suffering inherent in discipleship. But along with it, God's consolation.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Most of the "reality" shows tell me that I should be concerned about myself—be #1, no matter what it takes. How do I reconcile this with the Gospel injunction to lose my life for Jesus' sake?
2. As an individual, a town, a parish, do I look for the rewards that I believe are coming to me because of my status (personal or corporate), rather than serving the lowly in God's name?
3. What is Christ asking me to leave behind?
