SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

I wrote last week I would bring you up-to-date on the Mission in the Turks and Caicos. I went specifically for Holy Family Academy's graduations. So here's the up-date.

It's an interesting system because the school follows both the British and the American school systems. The school is a K to 12 institution. Children receive diplomas from the Island government and signed by the Minister of Education after the 8th grade and again after the 11th grade. The school has an arrangement with the Archdiocese of Miami for virtual classes for the 12th grade and so they receive a diploma after completing the 12th grade. In addition, like many American schools, there is also a kindergarten graduation, recognizing these young children's accomplishment in which is, for many, their first formal educational experience.

The school also has an arrangement with St. Thomas University in Miami. At the same time they are fulfilling requirements for graduation from high school (the 12th grade); they are also beginning college courses through St. Thomas. They are virtual but they are also in person as fully accredited professors come from the University for two or three week stretches for in-person classes. So these 12th graders are getting their "foot in the door" of St. Thomas University and then all but one will continue with St. Thomas in the fall.

But that's not the end of the story. One of the faculty has been working on summer internships for these students in businesses on the Islands to give them a taste of being on the local workforce. What a great program the school has, a faith based formation within the context and environment of an educational institution that will provide them with the tools to stay on the Island and build a better society. Holy Family Academy is a great ministry of the Catholic Mission in the Islands. To help strengthen this, the parish administration is looking to build a separate facility for the high school on lands the parish already owns. It's a far cry from the 12 students who first entered the Academy in the fall of 2006. God bless the hard work of the dedicated priests and lay people who have made it happen.

This is truly the **LAST CALL** to make a gift to the **Annual Appeal** which will help both the Archdiocese and the parish. As of today (Tuesday, 6/25), 482 households have contributed or pledged, up 8 from last week but we are still 8 short of the total who participated last year and 18 short of the magic 500 number. TODAY'S READINGS

1. **Wisdom 1: 13-15; 2: 23-24**

Attributed to Solomon, though, in fact composed much later, this book may be the last of the Old Testament books to be written. In reality, a work of a Hellenistic Jew, writing in Alexandria, Egypt, it is an exhortation to all Jews living outside Israel to remain faithful, in light of the fact that Jewish religious belief and thought is far superior to every other religion and philosophy. Today's excerpted passage affirms the belief that God is the author of all life and desires that every creature enjoy that gift of life to the fullest. Above all, human beings are created in God's image and are to be authentic reflections of that image by the uprightness of their lives, even though the devil, envious of our relationship with God, seeks to steer us down a different path.

2 **Corinthians 8: 7, 9, 13-15**

When we are convinced that Christ's love for us has been demonstrated by his self-sacrificing death, then we should be ready to love him in return and live, not for ourselves, but for him. Christ's resurrection gives us assurance that we, too, will rise from the dead. But because we are already in Christ, we experience a new reality even here, while we live on this earth for we see everything transformed by the Spirit.

3. **Mark 5:21-43**

Two separate stories, one inserted within the other, are held together by one central figure, Jesus, and by one theme, faith. Two completely opposite figures, Jairus, rich, well known, bold and the woman, poor, anonymous, secretive are taken up with fear, but convinced, through faith, that Jesus is the answer to their needs. For both, faith overcomes their fear and the result is new life, the fullness of which they now enjoy.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. What is my "world view"? Do I see the goodness of creation? What am I doing to preserve the goodness of the created world?
2. Paul appeals to the Corinthians to see their giving in light of their "model," Jesus. Do you see it in this light or perspective? Isn't this **Stewardship**? Do you practice it?
3. How has grace lifted me above my own failures and anxieties?
