TODAY'S READINGS

1. Isaiah 66:10-14

The closing oracles of Isaiah, from which this text is excerpted, celebrate the strengthened bond between Yahweh and His people. Redeemed and rejoicing, having been purified by their exile experience, Israel is in a position to appreciate that their true purpose was service to God. The tragedy of the past, Jerusalem destroyed, a people exiled, was symbolized in Isaiah as a widow bereft of her children. The restoration is symbolized as a joyful mother (Yahweh) caring for her infants. With their priorities in proper order, they enjoy blessings and gifts from their loving God.

2. Galatians 6:14-18

Regardless of how important the law and circumcision may have been in the past; Paul reaffirms them to be nothing in comparison to the self-giving death of Jesus Christ. His own suffering is a sharing in that same suffering of Jesus, as it will be for all believers, upon whom grace and mercy will descend if they join Paul in depending totally on Christ crucified.

3. Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

This excerpted passage almost implies the state of the early Christian community as it reaches out to the world. And its message is a simple one—God offers the world, through Jesus, the good news of peace, forgiveness and salvation. Nothing is to hinder the announcement of this message, or to delay it. These early preachers are to live by faith alone, and rely on God, and the care of the community. If this occurs, Jesus confirms the success of the effort, for those who undertake it are protected by the power of the Gospel. But this discipleship is not about power, but about salvation, for their names will be written in heaven.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Are there any situations in your life where Jesus wants you to go as His emissary of love, peace or reconciliation? Are you willing?
2. What keeps you from being more explicit and courageous about proclaiming in word and deed the message of salvation in Christ's suffering, death and resurrection?
3. Do you know someone who needs to hear that God is near?

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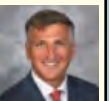
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
