SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

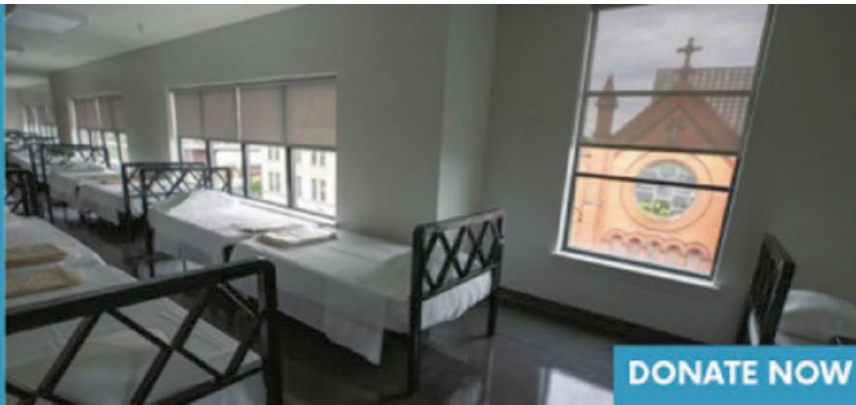

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Ezekiel 2:2-5

A member of the Zadokite priesthood, Ezekiel was among the first wave of deportees exiled to Babylon after the fall of Jerusalem. Four years later, he received his prophetic commission while in exile. Today's excerpted text is part of the commissioning aspect of the prophet's vocational encounter. In the overwhelming presence of God, Ezekiel collapses to the ground. But the spirit of God enters him and gives him the strength to rise up and to accept the challenge of the difficult task ahead, preaching to a people who are obstinate of heart, but who will eventually rise up from the dust, as he himself has just done.

2. 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Paul's admission of the cost of his discipleship in this second letter to the church at Corinth is part of what has come to be called his apologia. In this excerpted text, Paul is frank about the struggles he endured but has pledged to remain resolute in Christ's service. The cryptic "thorn in the flesh" continues to be debated as to its meaning; e.g., physical disability, an illness, a recurrent temptation, or even his opponents. Whatever its meaning, Paul accepts it as a weakness which attracts the power of Christ to bring him through this difficulty and all others of his ministry.

3. Mark 6:1-6

Having been engaged in a mostly successful preaching and healing ministry throughout Galilee, Jesus returns to his hometown, where he is not well received. As Mark presents it, it is not the content of His teaching that causes this reaction, it is that He teaches with his own authority, an authority which is rejected because He is well-known to them. Jesus, Himself, is amazed by this lack of faith. This unbelief and rejection affirms the fact that mighty deeds alone do not produce faith. Rather, it is up to the believer to create in themselves a welcome where God's word can find a foothold and the power of grace can begin to have its intended effect.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Can you think of times when weakness, challenges, or even failures, have led to a deeper faith in God?
2. What message of Christ do you find the hardest to accept? The hardest to see in others?
3. Who or what serves as a thorn in your flesh? Like Paul, do you see a benefit to this weakness?
