Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

On February, 20th, 2005, the parish bulletin announced a gift of \$2,401 to *Several Sources*, a shelter where pregnant women who chose life over abortion could go and have their babies. It represented the first **tithe**, 10% of the weekly collection that second Sunday of Lent. It began a long path of the parish's support for local charities, which we called **Sharing Our Gifts**. Over the course of the fifteen years that the parish has tithed (before Covid forced us to stop), the parish probably has donated about 1.3 million dollars to worthy causes. It was a remarkable expression of the generosity of this faith community to the parish which allowed the parish to mirror that generosity to others.

As I wrote last week, the parish will return to the practice of **tithing**, beginning with 5% of our ordinary monthly income (exclusive of the Assessment Collection, which is already a dedicated collection). We have had to change the procedure somewhat because over half our monthly income comes through electronic giving, and not necessarily each week in the "physical, in-pew" collection as it did years ago. The tithe will be taken on the total monthly collection and distributed to local charities that you propose. This part has not changed. We turn to you to make suggestions to charities that you know, and maybe even support yourselves. These can be food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, outreach organizations, anything that does a charitable work somewhere in the area. And the area doesn't have to be limited to Bergen County. It just can't be a national charity like the Red Cross or the Salvation Army, although there are some exceptions, like St. Jude's Hospital. The parish Finance Council will review all suggestions and apportion the monthly tithe accordingly. Please email me any suggestions you might want to be considered.

The tithe is possible because of your generosity to the parish and the parish's commitment to be as generous to others as you are to the parish. Thank you for making it possible for this faith community to reach beyond itself in its care for the needs of others.

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Deuteronomy 30:10-14

About to enter the Promised Land, the Israelites receive final words from Moses. God's word to them has been pure gift, not something they have earned, and that word is not hidden, nor is it hard to grasp. It is revealed to them through God's servants; it is simple and understandable and it is accessible to everyone because it comes from God and because it comes from God, Who never asks the impossible, every human being is capable of obeying.

2. Colossians 1:15-20

In this Christological hymn, Jesus Christ is identified as the image of God, the projection of God onto the human frame, one in whose words and works human beings can see the image of God reflected in love. As the "firstborn," Jesus represents the entire human community before God. He is the One in Whom all creation finds its origin, meaning and purpose. But not just head of creation, by His death and rising He has become head of the church as well, those who have been reconciled to the Father.

3. Luke 10:25-37

In one of the most famous parables that Jesus told, the real question of life is answered; not who is my neighbor but what does it mean to be neighbor. The precondition is an awareness that an all-embracing love of God that finds its expression in heart, soul, mind and strength is no love at all unless it is so expressed for anyone and everyone in need. Jesus' challenge admits of no excuses, conditions or exceptions or boundaries.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Do you see the commandments as expressions of God's love? How? Or are they limitations on your freedom?
2. Were you ever surprised to recognize God working in unexpected ways?
3. When have you "crossed the road" (really crossed the road) to help someone in need?
