Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

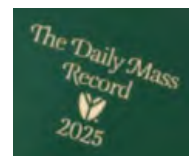
This will be an exciting opportunity to come together, share our experiences, and renew our commitment to our ministries. Mark your calendars and spread the word! More details will follow in coming weeks.

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Amos 7:12-15

One of the group of twelve Minor Prophets (so-called because they share a single scroll), Amos is, by trade, a shepherd and a migrant worker who is called by the Lord to go to the northern kingdom and preach a call to repentance. Bethel is the sanctuary set up by the royal house of the north to keep the people from going to the Temple in Jerusalem (in the southern kingdom). But in God's eyes, it is illegitimate, setup by men and not by God. Amos adds his message of God's opposition to the list of prophets who have already preached against it. His voice, like theirs, is unwelcome.

2. Ephesians 1:3-14

In this prayer of blessing with which Paul begins this letter to the Christian community at Ephesus (after the customary greeting), the rich descriptions of the character of God affirm the belief that God is the source of every blessing conferred on the believer, the first of which is the call or election to faith itself. The love with which this call is given gives the encouragement and strength the believer needs to bear the day-to-day burdens and struggles of ministry. This is assured through the gift of the Holy Spirit, the assurance of the abiding presence of Christ.

3. Mark 6:7-13

Having shown Jesus' ministry (in the earlier chapters) as defeating the forces of the demons, Mark now has Jesus share that ministry with those whom He has chosen (the Twelve). In their instruction, Jesus calls them not only to simplicity and mobility but also to realism, enter where they are welcome, leave and move on if they are not. With the commission and these instructions, the Twelve go off, reflecting the later experience of the Marcan community.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Even with all that's happening in our world, do you ever spend time in prayer pondering God's many blessings and graces and then singing his praises?
2. The call to mission in Jesus' name is for every Christian. What do you believe the Lord is calling you to do for Him and the Gospel?
3. Jesus' instruction to the Twelve is to travel light. What weighs you down in your daily life? In your mission to the world?
