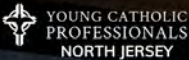

The Valley Health System Offers

The Family Care Center provides services for all: the insured, those with limited or no medical insurance, and persons who cannot afford private medical care. 1. Exodus 19:2-6

This excerpt situates the people at the foot of Mt. Sinai, following their escape from Egypt, but before the giving of the Law. Note the change in God's reference to them, at one moment "the house of Jacob," recalling the obstacles he and his family had to overcome to make progress in their journey of faith; at another moment, "the Israelites," recalling the name God gave to Jacob (Israel) after he learned to allow God to direct his life. It suggests his descendants must be ready to make that same change in their lives. If they do that, they will be to the Lord His special people.

2. Romans 5:6-11

Paul teaches that reconciliation is the work of God the Father accomplished by Jesus' death. Through His death and resurrection, God has broken down the enmity that was created by human sinfulness. Paul's own experience makes him realize the tremendous act of love on the part of the Father and Jesus, that He should die for us sinners. Through faith this pardon is appropriated and those same sinners are able to stand in peace before the Father Who loves them.

3. Matthew 9:36-10:8

In describing His hearers as troubled and abandoned, Jesus' words recall similar descriptions from the Prophets who bemoan the consequences of the poor leadership exercised by many of the nation's kings. As He witnesses their state, he chooses and sends twelve who will help with the mission. But like His, their leadership will be different, they are sent to proclaim Good News and to heal, which they will accomplish through Jesus' power. Unlike the kings, this will be a leadership of service, given freely by God to the disciples, to be given freely for others.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. What can I do in response to Jesus' truth that the "laborers are few"? Did I respond to **Called By Name** or take it seriously?
2. Where and how can I be a laborer for Christ's harvest?
3. What can I do about the needs of a "troubled and abandoned" world?
