Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

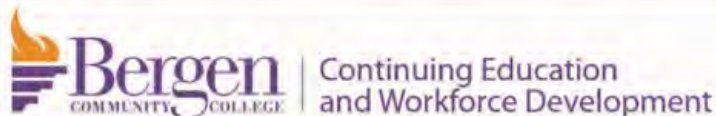

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Genesis 18:1-10

Though at first glance a story about hospitality, this encounter of Abraham and Sarah with their divine guests reveals the ever-present tension between God's surprising promise and human resistance. In omitted verses, Abraham and Sarah enjoy a good laugh about the promise of a child. In response, the divine guest asks if there is anything too marvelous for the Lord to do. This is the question that is essential to all discipleship. Abraham's growing reliance on God will prove to have its own reward—the much wanted offspring.

2. Colossians 1:24-28

Countering his rivals who claim his imprisonment showed his failure, Paul asserts that through these very sufferings, he is being made more and more like Christ and that, further, he is a symbol of the new Israel (the Church) which will continue to bear them until Christ's return in glory. Likewise, all believers will experience Christ in the same way; in their sufferings they will be transformed by Christ to become more Christ-like.

3. Luke 10:38-42

This simple and familiar scene carries three important lessons. The most obvious is the need for the disciple to place a priority on being attentive to the word of the Lord. Daily concerns cannot become distractions from that word. The second lesson is close to the first; it is this listening, this closeness to the Lord that provides the fuel for service; Jesus feeds the disciple before the disciple can feed others. The third lesson is that no one is excluded from closeness to the Lord. In the first reading, Sarah stayed in the tent, out of sight. Normal near east protocol would be for the women to stay in the cooking area and would not join with the guests. Jesus shatters all boundaries. No one is denied access to the word of the Lord, regardless of gender, custom or social boundary.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have your good works attuned you to God's presence in your daily life?
2. Have your good works helped you hear the good news? To hear God's voice in the ordinary activities of your daily life?
3. How does this Gospel invite you to grow in your relationship with the Lord through your daily living?
