Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

A TEENAGE SAINT??? REALLY???

There has been quite a bit of talk surrounding the recent announcement by Pope Francis on the approval to name Carlo Acutis a saint in the Catholic Church. Why the talk? Well, first Carlo will become the first Millennial Saint (those born between 1981 & 1996) and second, he was only fifteen at the time of his death.

What could a fifteen-year-old have done to be recognized as a saint and in relatively such a short time after death?

Carlo Acutis was born (1991) to Italian parents who were living in London, England at the time. Shortly thereafter, they moved back to Italy.

As Carlo attended both elementary and middle school, he developed an interest in Marian apparitions and Eucharistic Miracles. He encouraged his family to take trips to Fatima and Lourdes as well as other places of recognized apparitions.

He then used his love of computers (he was versed in four different programming languages... self-taught) to create a website cataloging the Eucharistic Miracles.

Carlo also believed teenagers could make a difference in the world through volunteering. He volunteered weekly with the homeless, collected trash along the ocean's shores to protect the environment and taught religious education at his home parish. And yes, he was a member of the youth group! He constantly encouraged his peers to make a difference.

On October 1, 2006, Carlo was diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia. On October 4, 2006, his Eucharistic Miracles website was launched. On October 11th Carlo suffered a cerebral hemorrhage due to the leukemia and died the next day, October 12th the Feast Day of his favorite saint... Francis of Assisi.

With Pope Francis' announcement, Blessed Carlo Acutis will become Saint Carlo Acutis sometime in 2025. The date has not yet been announced.

IS CARLOS ACUTIS THE FIRST TEENAGE SAINT? NO!
As a matter of fact, we have a slew of teenage saints!
Here are a few others...

- St. Stanislaus Kostka—Age 17 (1550-1568) A member of the Society of Jesus. It was said "he was the model and mirror of religious perfection".
- St. Teresa of the Andes—Age 19 (1900-1920) Inspired by St. Therese of Lisieux, Teresa became a Discalced Carmelite nun in Chile, where she died of Typhus.
- St. Catherine of Alexandria—Age 18 (c.287-c.305) Born of nobility, she was a notable scholar in the sciences and Christianity. The Emperor Maximinus brought his top men to debate her, but they all failed. Some even converted to Christianity and were instantly martyred. The emperor had Catherine beheaded.
- St. Pedro Calungsod—Age 17 (1654-1672) A missionary in Guam ministering to the Chamorro people who eventually turned against the missionaries and martyred them. He was canonized in 2012.
- St. Dominic Savio—Age 14 (1842-1957) Guided by St. John Bosco, who after Dominic's death, wrote his biography describing Dominic's miracles and intense love for God.

- St. Philomena—Age 13 (c. 291-c.304) Her grave was not discovered until 1802. She was a Greek princess who was martyred.
- St. Jose Sanchez del Rio—Age 14 (1913-1928) Jose was captured in Mexico during the Cristero Rebellion. The government tried to suppress the Catholic Church and mandate secularization. Jose was tortured and killed after refusing to denounce his belief in Jesus.

- St. Joan of Arc—Age 19 (1412-1431)
- St. Nunzio Sulprizio—Age 19 (1817-1836)
- St. Dymphna—Age 14 (7th Century)
- St. Agnes of Rome—Age 13 (c.291-c.304)

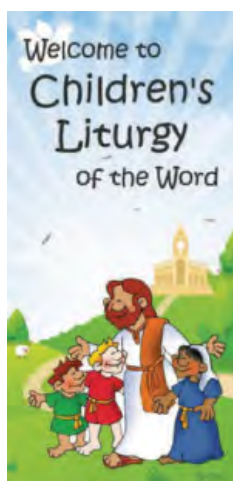

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Jeremiah 23:1-6

Jeremiah challenged the rulers of his day to serve God instead of themselves, using the image of a shepherd who pastures his sheep with virtue and fidelity to God. Today's excerpt is an oracle against the last king of Judah, Zedekiah, who refuses to listen and change and is forewarned that the sheep will be scattered, the kingdom will collapse. But because God is a true Shepherd, He will gather His people and bring them back and appoint for them a new shepherd, in the image of David, who will rule by the standards of heaven.

2. Ephesians 2:13-18

Paul contrasts the time before and the time after one has come to believe in Christ. The former was marked by enmity, estrangement and distance. The latter by friendship, oneness and closeness. Those who were far off have now become near. All of this has been made possible through Jesus, who shed his blood for both. By dying on the cross, Jesus established peace, bringing together Gentile and Jew, who are now one with God and with one another.

3. Mark 6:30-34

Having been busy carrying out their mission and ministry of healing and preaching, the apostles return to Jesus, who sees that they are in need of some rest. How totally ordinary a situation. But their attempts at some R & R prove fruitless, as the crowds pursue and find them. As portrayed by Mark, they are enthusiastic to hear more. As Jesus disembarks from the boat, He is moved with compassion for these people who are wandering aimlessly, like the ancient Israelites in the wilderness. God has promised to lead them himself, and now He does so, in the ministry of Jesus, the Son.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have you ever had a flash of insight (as Jesus did in today's Gospel)? Did you act on it?
2. What strength does Jesus give you? How can you draw upon that strength to bring hope and peace to a world struggling with so much violence and uncertainty?
3. Like Paul, do you see Jesus as your peace? What kind of peace does Jesus offer?
