Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

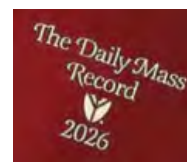

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Genesis 18:20-32

The faith-filled life of Abraham, evident in last week's excerpt about welcoming the divine, is followed this week by the darkness of Sodom, whose reputation for sinfulness was so pronounced that its name has become synonymous with depravity. God reveals His plans for the destruction of Sodom to Abraham, affirming Abraham's close bond to God. Intervening on behalf of the few just who may be present in Sodom, this excerpted passage teaches an obvious lesson about trust and familiarity in prayer.

2. Colossians 2:12-14

The consequence of having received Christ, which Paul urges in last week's reading, is described in symbolic language in this excerpted passage. We are buried in our sinfulness with Christ so that, through our faith in Him, we may be raised to new life. This resurrection, then, consists in that forgiveness. Paul describes it as nailing this bond to the cross. A bond was a sort of "I owe you." It described a debt between a creditor and the debtor. In this case, God is the creditor and we, through our sinfulness, are the debtors and the bond of that debt has now been nailed to the cross of Christ and thus—forgiven.

3. Luke 11:1-13

In this excerpted passage, Luke, presents Jesus' primer on prayer. It is characterized by its simplicity and boldness. The disciple prays first for the coming of the kingdom, only then for sustenance, forgiveness and protection from the final test. The disciple can pray with boldness because of his/her particular close relationship with the Father in Jesus. And the disciple should pray with persistence, whether the response is immediately forthcoming or not, because the disciple is one who knows, through Jesus, that God cares.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. How might persistence in prayer change you as much as you think it influences God?
2. Though you may pray the *Our Father* every day, do you earnestly seek God in every moment of that day?
3. Are you the reluctant neighbor when someone knocks on your door? Do you open your door to those in need?
