Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2: 21-23

Regarded as part of Wisdom Literature, this book, ascribed to Solomon, studies the relationship between God and humankind, not in terms of the covenant or "salvation history," but strictly from an earthly viewpoint. The author tests everything, pleasure, riches, toil, even wisdom, and finds them all lacking. Preoccupation with these things leads only to the illusion of satisfaction. The conclusion—gratitude to God for whatever blessings He chooses to send, for God is not limited or coerced by human considerations.

2. Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

In these beginning lines of chapter 3, the contrast is to be understood in terms of the religious practices of the past (food and drink, festivals of the new moon or Sabbath—cited in the previous verses) and Christ's victorious presence, a lordship earned through His complete victory over sin and death. Through baptism, the Christian embraces a new life in Christ, a life marked by a continuous, interior renewal, a life and renewal in which all previous barriers are broken down.

3. Luke 12:13-21

Having been asked to arbitrate a family dispute (a not uncommon experience for one regarded as possessing an unusual degree of wisdom), Jesus uses the occasion to pronounce a deeper truth—the real meaning of one's life cannot be determined or secured by one's possessions. The farmer is not described as unjust or evil; he merely subscribes to an erroneous attitude—bigger is better. In his planning, he has paid no attention to God or what God might be asking of him.

1. Despite all your knowledge, skill, work, worry, effort, riches and success, have you ever felt empty?
2. What are your "barns," where you store what is most valuable to you?
3. How do you "seek what is above"? Put on a new self? Find renewal in God?
