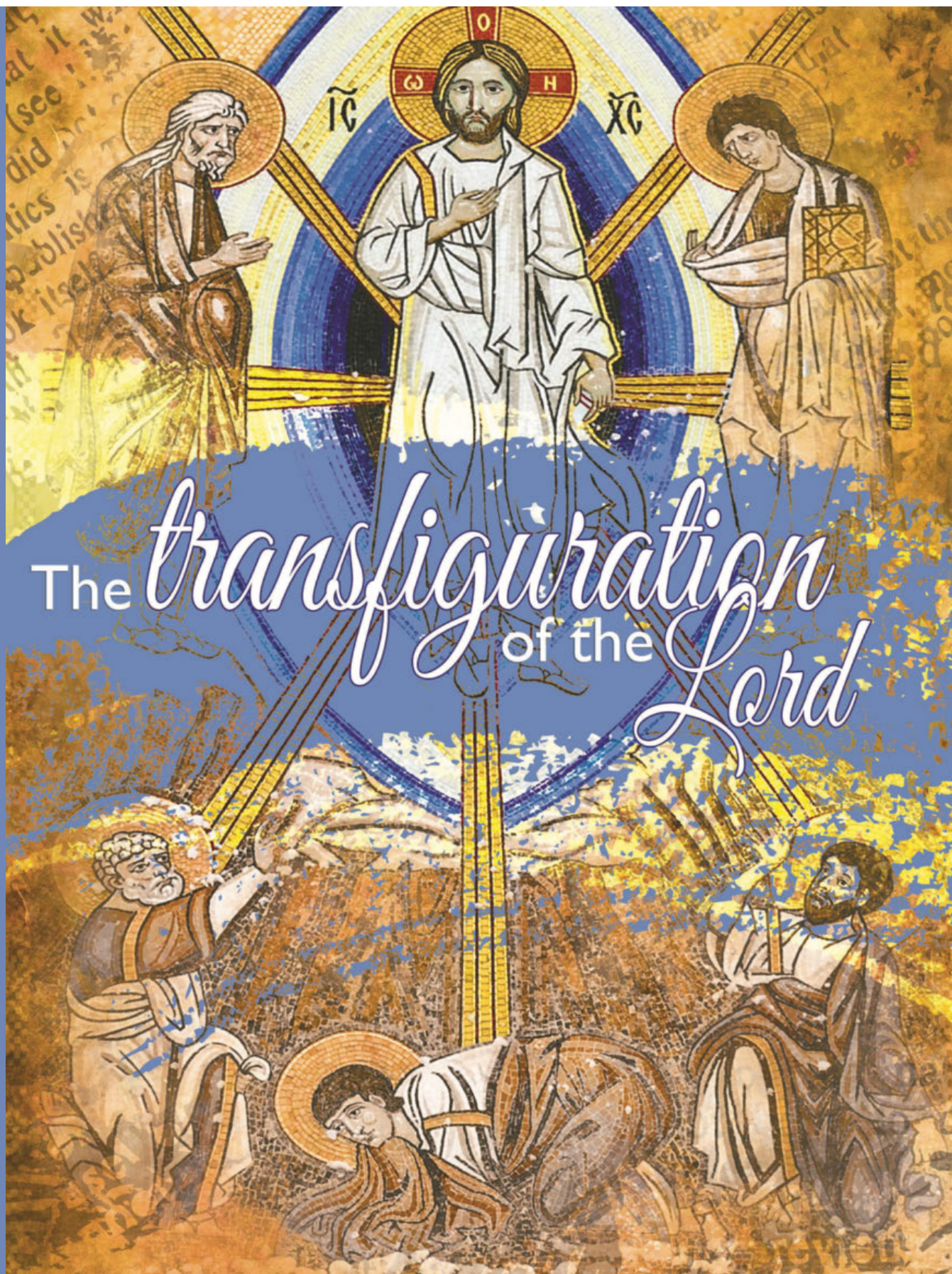

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration (PEA) is quiet adoration of Jesus 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There is a scheduled Adorer every hour to be with Jesus. We cannot leave Jesus alone in the chapel. If the scheduled Adorer cannot make his/her hour, he/she calls in to find a substitute Adorer to make sure we are praying 24/7.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration provides the opportunity for us to see our lives in proper perspective. We contemplate on God's love, mercy, divine providence, His call to us (our mission, our purpose), on our own needs/desires as well as of family/friends and of the world. We need this silence with God to reflect on how we are doing in life. Here in Ridgewood and surrounding areas, we often are driven by our desire to win, to excel, to be rich, to be on top of what we do. There is nothing wrong with that because we are to use our talents. But at Adoration, we have a deeper awakening. Many people, even though they are rich and winners or for some when something goes wrong in their lives are still restless. At Adoration, we find peace because we try to relate our desires/achievements to God's will. Are we doing everything we can for the glory of God? If we are doing everything for our glory, we will always be restless, not sure where we are going next. But if we focus on Jesus Christ, on Romans 11:36, all our success and failures will have meaning and we can see the presence of God in our lives,

PEA keeps our eyes, mind and heart on Jesus Christ even for just an hour. We call this a Holy Hour. You will be amazed at what this one hour can do in your life and in the lives of your loved ones. Come and join us. Sign up for an hour that is good for you. You can also try being a substitute if your schedule is irregular.

1. Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14

Up to this point in his vision, Daniel has seen the terrible beasts surrounding God's people. Now he sees a more awesome and more assuring vision of the heavenly court. The Ancient One, the eternal God, takes His throne. The white expresses His absolute purity, in contrast to the earthiness of the beasts and the fire expresses the purifying judgment in store for the wayward world. The court awaits the coming of the One entirely devoted to serving the Ancient One, the new Israel, but understood by the Church as Jesus, the Lord.

2. Peter 1:16-19

Peter writes in response to those who have given up on God and belief in God's involvement in human history. He assures us that the message given us through the apostles was given directly by God and is not of human origin. Faith is not a mythical journey but recognition of God among us and the need to build on those moments of recognition when we have felt God's power, love and presence.

3. Matthew 17:1-9

The affirmation of Jesus by the Father to Jesus alone at His baptism is now extended to His disciples, and in an even deeper way. He is the beloved Son. All are to listen to Him to find life. Ever so briefly, the disciples see Jesus for who he really is in his divine nature, and in his role as the fulfillment of the Law (Moses) and the prophets (Elijah). Though not explicitly stated, the Transfiguration celebrates who Jesus is as God's Son in revelation, even as it proclaims God's plan for humanity.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. On a human level, have you ever had an experience where you come to see a person in a new light, revealing something more about them and who they really are?
2. Have you ever had an experience of God's profound presence in your life?
3. Building tents can mean clinging to something, e.g. persons, events, habits, etc. What do you cling to in your life and is it good for your growth as a person, a disciple?
