SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Everyone is invited to come to the PEA chapel at any time to give praise and thanks to God and to pray for our loved ones and all of mankind. The chapel is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, even overnight.

How Do We Spend Our Holy Hour?

There is no set rule for spending a Holy Hour before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The most important thing is simply to be with Him. However, the following guide may help:

First 15 Minutes—Be Still

Relax, quiet your mind, and rest in His presence. As Scripture says, *“Be still and know that I am God.”* Allow yourself to slow down and become aware that Jesus is truly present before you.

Second 15 Minutes—Speak with Jesus

Talk to Jesus as you would to a close friend. Share your joys and sorrows, your worries, your desires, and your needs. You may also pray the Holy Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, or other favorite prayers.

Third 15 Minutes—Listen to Jesus

Spend this time in silence. Let Jesus gaze upon you and speak to your heart. Listen quietly and allow His peace and love to fill you.

Last 15 Minutes—Receive and Reflect

Ask Jesus for a virtue or grace that you need most—patience, wisdom, humility, courage, perseverance, or trust. Reflect on how you can live that virtue in your daily life. Let this be your takeaway from your Holy Hour.

Remember, the purpose of a Holy Hour is not to do many things, but simply to spend time with Jesus, who loves you and desires to be with you.

Come and spend an hour FOR and WITH JESUS. He will take care of the rest—our family, our livelihood, our relationships, our health. God is never outdone in generosity.

Our goal is to have two Scheduled Adorers every hour and to fill all 24 hours with an Hour Coordinator.

TODAY'S READINGS

1. **Kings 19:9, 11-13**

In the Old Testament, wind, earthquake and fire were regarded as media for divine communication, signaling the divine presence. Elijah goes, at God's command, to the holy mountain (Sinai or Horeb) where God spoke to Moses and where He will now speak to Elijah. But contrary to expectations, God does not speak in these usual powerful forces of nature. Instead, He speaks in a whisper choosing to be known in the quiet stillness of the human heart, made calm by its belief and serene in its hope. Thus made calm, Elijah is now prepared to accept the new assignments God has in store for him.

2. **Romans 9:1-5**

Healed and made whole by Jesus' love for him, Paul ached to extend the blessings he had come to know in the risen Christ to his fellow Jews, even to the extent of his willingness to be separated from Christ, if only they would accept Christ themselves. Paul reminds his Jewish brethren of all they have received from God, the covenant, the law, the promises, the worship and, ultimately, the Son. Would that they would only accept Him as their greatest blessing.

3. **Matthew 14:22-33**

Hidden in the middle of this passage is a simple, yet profound statement on Jesus' part. "It is I." Jesus' response to the fear of the disciples is couched in the same phrase as God is identified to Moses on Mt. Sinai. Jesus is here identified with God and does what God does, calming the raging storm and walking on the water. Jesus thus identifies Himself as God and the disciples will come to recognize this at the end of the passage. Only with eyes fixed on Christ, the Son of God, will they be kept from sinking, as Peter did.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Has God ever spoken to you in a whisper? Do you even give Him the quiet time you need to hear and listen?
2. What storms threaten to engulf your boat (life)? Have you ever experienced a similar time when Jesus kept you from drowning?
3. Have you ever felt overwhelmed by fear? Has your faith in Jesus' love and presence given you reassurance and peace?
