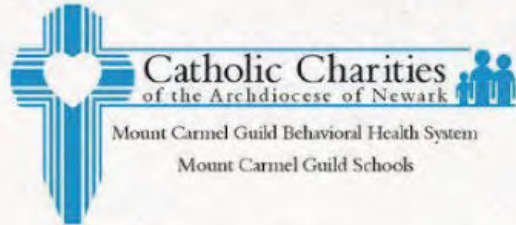

Our Lady of Mount Carmel
World Youth Day 2023

Couples from our parish led two pilgrimage groups with different itineraries on a pilgrimage for the World Youth Day with Pope Francis in Lisbon, Portugal. Each of the two groups had over a hundred people, mostly between the ages of twelve and twenty-five. Between the two groups, which included parishioners from other parishes, our parish sent almost a hundred young people to the World Youth Day.

The group that I accompanied landed in Madrid on Tuesday, August 1st and began a whirlwind of activity. We traveled to Segovia, Avila, Fatima, Lisbon, Porto, and Zamora. We began everyday with Morning Prayer and ended with either a Eucharist or Evening Prayer. Each day, the young people took advantage of the opportunities that they had to share about how the pilgrimage was helping them to see the events of their lives in a new way, in light of the Word of God. The sincerity with which they spoke was, for me, the most impressive thing that I witnessed. Almost all of them were without their cell phones.

Of course, attending the Mass in Lisbon on Sunday, August, 6th, with 1.5 million pilgrims, presided by Pope Francis, was a major highlight. The following day, we attended a vocational meeting with over 100,000 young people in the Neocatechumenal Way from around the world. On Wednesday, August 9th, we celebrated Mass with about 8,000 American pilgrims at *Finis Terrae*. *Finis Terrae* is Latin for “the end of the earth. It earned this name because, when it was commonly believed that the world was flat, *Finis Terrae* was believed to be the end. *Finis Terrae* is also the end of the traditional pilgrimage of the *Camino de Santiago*. It was spectacular.

At the vocational meeting, the organizers invited any young man who desired to follow the call to be a priest to come up to the stage and receive a blessing and then did likewise for young women who were interested in discerning a call to religious life. From our parish, seven young men and ten young women expressed a desire to discern God’s will regarding the priesthood or religious life.

On Friday, August 11th, I was in the Town Square of Madrid (the *Plaza Mayor*), as Neil and Carmen Condon and Stefano and Elizabeth Gennarini, the responsables of our pilgrimage, were checking to make sure that our group was all accounted for. As I stood there, a local Spanish woman asked me if the nearby youth were World Youth Day pilgrims. When I told her that they were, she said, “You can always identify the young people here on pilgrimage by how happy they are.”

Soon after, we set back off to our buses, in a procession of over a hundred people, singing psalms and playing instruments, with a processional cross and an American flag at the head as well as a banner mentioning that we were from Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Ridgewood, NJ. As was typical, the people we passed greeted us with smiles, recorded us on their phones, and some joined us.

By now, everyone is settled back into “normal life,” but the

joy of the pilgrimage remains a memorial of God's action for all of us. I thank all of you who helped to make this pilgrimage possible through your contributions and your participation in "Pennies for Pilgrims." I am also thankful to all of you who prayed for us while we were away.

Before I left, Msgr. Ron told me that he wanted our group to pray for our parish every day, at every holy site we visited. I made sure that we did. So, know that you were in our prayers.

1. Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

As a sign of Israel's change of heart and readiness to listen to God's word, a new spirit of the observance of the Sabbath reflects the proper point of view on life. It humbles the exaggerated notion that all of value was of man's making and reestablishes God's sovereignty over the world He created. So important is this recognition that the prophet looks to a time when all the nations, not just Israel, will acknowledge this sovereignty in worship in the great Temple.

2. Romans 11:13-15, 29-32

Paul recognizes that Israel's privileges are irrevocable. God will not abandon His people. But in the meantime, Israel's rejection of Jesus has turned to the advantage of the gentiles. They now have come to experience God's mercy in believing in Jesus. Eventually, Paul believes, his fellow Jews will come to recognize God's hand in saving the gentiles.

3. Matthew 15:21-28

The dynamic of this story of the Canaanite woman (a pagan) unfolds around the dialogue she had with Jesus at her instigation. Though a pagan, she acknowledges him as "Lord, Son of David," a messianic title. Somehow, she knows and believes. At first, Jesus rejects her, reaffirming his exclusive commitment to the Jews, even to the point of a derogatory dismissal of her need. But because of her persistence, her faith triumphs and is rewarded with the cure she seeks. In this dialogue, Matthew teaches his community (of predominantly Jewish Christians) that the power of faith transcends every divide.
