Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

For me, it's hard to believe that the weeks of summer have come and gone. I start off by reminding the parish of two events coming up within the next eight days. The first is the annual remembrance of 9/11, this Monday evening at 7:00PM. It is a moment to remember those lost on that tragic day, especially the members of our parish community and the larger Ridgewood community as well, to pray for them, the families that still mourn for them and for a world that doesn't seem to have learned any lessons, lasting ones anyway, from that horrific day. On the first anniversary I had said that we would continue to remember for as long as I was pastor, never expecting that twenty-one years later I would still be here. But in all likelihood, without it being an absolute and that circumstances could change, I will retire come June, 2024, so this will be the last of these remembrances of this kind, although we will continue to set aside the 12:00 noon Mass on 9/11 to be offered for those whose lives were so unjustly taken. I invite everyone, especially those who were part of this parish community in 2001, to come on Monday evening and join together in prayer and, remembrance and respect for all those we lost on that day.

Next Sunday is the annual celebration of our parish which we have come to simply call **THE BLOCK PARTY**. Food fun and games. All for free. If you are an "old timer," meaning you've been in the parish for a while, reconnect with people you may not have seen all summer. If you are new to the parish, meaning you were not around for the last one, come and meet and make new friends. It's a wonderful opportunity just to enjoy each other's company and it's the parish's way of saying thank you for being part of us. While I wouldn't want this heat wave to continue, I hope some of the fine weather can be saved for next Sunday.

I hope everyone will put both of these moments on your calendars. In some way, they both say a lot about who we are.

1. Ezekiel 33:7-9

A prophet was called by God at critical times in the relationship between God and His people to speak a word on God's behalf, a task the prophets sometimes found difficult and personally dangerous. In this excerpted passage, Ezekiel must warn about the consequences of Judah's failure to repent. Judah's subservience to Babylon was already its result of its failure to repent. Continuing in that failure would only bring worse consequences. Ezekiel is held personally responsible by God if he fails to deliver God's message, difficult as it may be.

2. Romans 13:8-10

Having spent the first seven verses of this chapter outlining obligations to those in authority, Paul tells his readers that the only real debt we have is to love. To flesh out this commandment on love, Paul refers to several specific commands, concluding that love is the fulfillment of the law.

3. Matthew 18:15-20

Christianity manifests a radical, communal self-understanding. The Church is more than a collection of isolated believers as evidenced in the text which indicates that from early on the community had a process for dealing with disputes and dissension. The process was threefold: (1) between the parties themselves, (2) between the perpetrator and several witnesses, (3) finally, between the perpetrator and the whole church community. If it is then still unresolved, the perpetrator may be thrown out. In Matthew's eyes, Jesus has given the Church the power to bind and loose in such instances. But since the goal of the Church is to build up the community, it is just such instances that it should turn to prayer, knowing that when it gathers in prayer, her Lord is with her.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. What can be the consequences of the prophetic calling to speak the truth? In the midst of the unrest in our society today, who are those who call us to the truth?
2. What does it take to really listen to and hear the voice of Christ?
3. Who challenges us, as a community and as individuals, to reflect on how we are living in the light of Christ's teaching and example?

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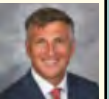
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
