Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

1. Numbers 21:4-9

The second generation of Hebrews sometimes prove themselves no more faithful than the original generation which the Lord led out of Egypt. In today's excerpted passage, they grumble about the hardships of their journey, especially the "heavenly bread," the manna, on which they have been fed for so many years. In turning their back on this wonderful gift, they turn their back on the generous God Who has provided for them. In turn, God sends serpents as a punishment. While not removing the serpents, perhaps as a reminder of the dangers of straying off the path of life, God provides antidote through which they can be saved.

2. Philippians 2:6-11

Paul quotes a hymn of salvation so that his hearers may find in it a pattern for their own lives. Unlike Adam, who sought to become equal to God, Jesus empties Himself, not of His divinity, but of His clinging to it and surrenders Himself to God's will for Him, holding nothing back for self, even to the cross. Because of this great gift of self, Jesus is vindicated by God, raised on high and given the name reserved only to God—*LORD*.

3. John 3:13-17

At the time of this writing, Jewish piety held that different people of the past have ascended into heaven, experienced the mysteries found there and returned to earth to reveal them to all. In this excerpt, the Evangelist rejects that with a clear teaching that the one and only true revealer of the divine mysteries is the man Jesus. Jesus will fulfill God's saving design by being lifted up, crucified, exalted and glorified. Jesus triumphs on and from His holy cross. The summary faith of the Christian life is contained in one of the most famous of all verses, John 3:16.
