Dear Friends

First, thank you to all who attended the 9/11 Memorial Mass last Sunday. Because 9/11 was a Sunday we did not add a special Mass but used the regularly scheduled 6:30PM Mass as the Memorial Mass. It somewhat changed the character of the remembrance but, nonetheless, the families of the victims were appreciative of the presence of those who still remember.

The Sunday of this weekend is our annual Block Party, from 1:30PM-5:00PM behind the Religious Education Center (the former convent). Last year, when we resumed after the pandemic shut us down in 2020, it was cool and rainy and we were forced into the gym. This year, forecasters are predicting a warm, sunny day, with temperatures in the mid-80s. What a perfect way to kick-off a return to full-scale parish life. Start with coming to Mass either Saturday evening or Sunday. At every Mass, there will be the Blessing of Backpacks (for a successful school year), with a gift for the children. So we hope all our parish families with children will participate. And, of course, come to the Block Party itself. This is an event for everyone in the parish, not just families with children. While most of the rides and games are for children, there is always free food and the chance to walk around, in the sun, and renew friendships with people you may not have seen, literally, “in years.” And, of course, there is the ever-present **dunk tank**, for your “viewing enjoyment.” Please come. I’m sure it will be an afternoon of laughs, relaxation and fun.

We’re only into the 3rd week of September and the beginning of the new program year and already I feel a renewed excitement and enthusiasm for “being back.” I’ve attended three different “openings,” of ministries already, 175 families with children in the Jr. High Youth Ministry, the umbrella which covers Religious Ed for that age group, the MOM’s and Women’s Cornerstone. It was exciting for me to see real live faces again and a renewed and refreshed commitment to “get the ball rolling.” What a difference from last year. As I’ve said before, each one of us, individually, and every family, needs to come to a decision as to how we live life with this new reality—a pandemic that may never really go away. And I would not presume to tell anyone how to do that, respecting the good judgment every person needs to guide their decisions about their safety. I would only ask that these decisions be made in conjunction with other decisions that may have already been made about, social life, work life and school life. From what I’ve experienced so far, I

am enthusiastic about and encouraged for the year ahead.

I hope you've had a chance to see the video on the homepage of the website about the upcoming **Fall House Gatherings**. I know it would never have been nominated for last week's Emmy's but I hope it gets across, in yet another format, the one main goal and push of the parish for the coming year—to **renew, refresh, rebuild and reconnect**, as a parish family, a family of faith. No, even more—to **grow closer to Jesus and to one another**. It will remain the principle theme of the entire year.

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TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. Amos 8:4-7

Amos, a shepherd and migrant worker in the Kingdom of Judah, is called by God to prophesy in the Northern Kingdom of Israel. He is most recognizable for exposing social injustices. Amidst the prosperity of the times, Amos preaches against the greed of the merchants whose wealth comes at the expense of the poor whom they regularly cheat. In addition, these merchants devalue the festivals and the Sabbath by scheming to continue their dishonest practices even as they offer their prayers to Yahweh, the protector of the poor.

2. 1 Timothy 2:1-8

The author, and his readers, is still living in the throes of the harsh persecution of Domitian. And so, they are exhorted to pray for everyone, including civil authority, without anger or argument. The reason cited for this approach is the author's insistence that God will all to be saved, even those who persecute the faithful. All this flows from the truth that Jesus is the one mediator between God and all human beings.

3. Luke 16:1-13

One of the more controversial parables, this excerpted text contains a seeming contradiction. The dishonest manager is also presented as someone to be imitated. Having been discovered to be a squanderer of his master's resources, the manager knows he will be dismissed. To ensure he will have open doors for his future, the steward foregoes his own commission, reducing what is owed to his master. He is willing to sacrifice his immediate profit for the sake of future benefits. Thus, he is praised for the clever and shrewd way he prepares for the future. Christians, likewise, should be so shrewd in preparing for the life to come.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. What do I need to learn from today's Gospel? How resourceful am I when it comes to living and announcing the Gospel message?
2. Do I use the worldly gifts God has given me, whatever they may be, as tools for the spreading of the Gospel?
3. Does our consumerist culture still "trample upon the needy and destroy the poor of the land"?
