SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

On the spiritual side. I've shared with you that I am reading a book entitled *33 Days to Eucharistic Glory*. It's a sort of pilgrim's guide to 33 days of reflection on the Eucharist. While it's dogmatic/spiritual theology, it's more of a 33 day retreat, leading to growing in a Eucharistic based spiritual life, a journey into the heart of Catholicism—the Holy Eucharist.

Each day, Matthew Kelly, the author, presents a different theme, with a lesson and a related virtue to practice, always pointing to the Eucharist. Today, I'm on day 22 and the heading of the day is **A Difficult Teaching**. There is an earlier book by Kelly entitled *Difficult Teachings—The 40 Most Challenging Teaching of Jesus*. I'm sure you can name some of them right off the bat, who is my neighbor (The Good Samaritan), love your enemies, turn the other cheek, judging others, etc. The one that Kelly cites as the foundation of this day is the Eucharist, precisely the Real Presence of Christ in the consecrated bread and wine. "Amen, Amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day." (John 6:53-54).

These are a part of Chapter 6 of the Gospel of John that we read throughout the month of August. Kelly makes the point that this has always been one of the most difficult teachings of Jesus to accept, even as Jesus himself was announcing it. In the Gospel, there were three reactions to this teaching: (1) the people disputed among themselves, (2) this is a hard saying, who can listen to it and (3) many disciples drew back and no longer went with him (abandonment).

From these, Kelly draws the question, "what are you hungry for in your life?" Right now? Stop right here and before you go any further, ask yourself that question. We are all hungry for something. Some may be hungry for food, although probably not many in the area in which we live. Then there are the less tangible things that many are hungry for—comfort, belonging (relationships), success, safety, adventure, excitement, security, travel. And many times, when the hunger for that particular thing is satisfied, we realize that we are really not that satisfied and we go on to hunger for something else, thinking **it will satisfy the yearning** we feel inside us. Some are caught in this cycle their whole lives. Others begin to realize that the yearning we feel, the yearning to be complete, is in some mysterious way a yearning for God. As St. Augustine put it, "our heart is restless until it rests in you."

And the perfect and complete fulfillment of this "restlessness" is in the Eucharist. "I am the bread of life; he who comes to me shall not hunger, and he who believes in me shall never thirst. (John 6:35)." When we think of understanding the ins and outs of human nature we may think of Freud or Skinner or Pavlov or Rogers, but how

about Jesus Christ. The Gospels give us the picture of a man who understood so completely how we tick and his answer to this restlessness is Himself, the Bread of Life who truly satisfies our hunger, like no one or nothing else. **Only God can satisfy your endless longing.**

If you're intrigued by Kelly's book, and the 33 day pilgrimage he invites you on, you can order it through Amazon or on kindle. If you've never made a pilgrimage, this might be a good place to start.

On the material side. If you've looked quickly at this edition of the bulletin, even before you've read my column, you will have noticed the announcement of a golf outing. I have to confess it's a little embarrassing to see something named after yourself (especially since I'm not dead yet). I've turned down requests like this in the past but I couldn't turn this one down because I believe so strongly in Catholic education/formation in a Catholic school—a quality education in a wholly Catholic environment. But I also know the limitations families deal with these days, especially the financial ones. I wish we could offer a totally free Catholic education but we can't. So I offer my name to an event which I hope will help provide extra support to our parochial school, the Academy of Our Lady. If you are a golfer, I hope you can participate. If not, maybe you can make a donation. In any case, thanks for your support for AoOL.

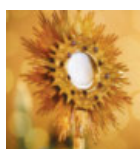
Weekly Scripture Reflection Thursday Mornings

- 1. Wisdom 2:12, 17-20**
Thought to be the last of the books of the Old Testament, this book exhorts readers to live by the standards of heaven, in right relationship to God, leading to advantages the world can never match. Today's excerpt is part of a larger section promoting the wisdom of faith over the craftiness of the world. The wicked dismiss the just one as an obstacle to their plans, plotting to kill him, sure that his trust will come to nothing. Though they may seem to win, they will discover too late that the eternal God will bring them to judgment.
- 2. James 3:16-4:3**
James reminds a community, apparently torn by some kind of conflict, that they can be led astray by the baser instincts of the human spirit. Selfishness and jealousy ruin our relationship with God and others. Followers of Christ, on the other hand, live in such a way as to produce the fruits of peace.
- 3. Mark 9:30-37**
Three times in Mark Jesus predicts His suffering, death and resurrection and three times the disciples fail to understand. In this second of such predictions, the consequences of such a role for the Messiah are seen in the way authority is to be exercised in the community. He has come to found. Reluctant to disclose to him the subject of their arguing, the disciples cling to notions of power and prestige. Jesus states the basic principle of discipleship, service, and illustrates it by reference to a child, not his/her innocence and goodness, but rather as those occupying the lowest rung on the social ladder. Authentic discipleship is about giving us status, moving down the social ladder, not up it.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Do you see upright and honest living as a futile exercise in everyday life? Why?
2. Have you ever plotted or schemed to get a better promotion, a bigger favor, more attention? How?
3. How might your daily life look different if you sought to live it more fully in purity, peacefulness, gentleness and mercy?
