Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

Because life moves so fast, and we often don't have time to stop and look around us, we may not realize it but our culture continues to eat away at our faith life through all of the messages that tell us either we don't need to bother that much about religion, or, at most, just keep it tucked into a very small corner of our lives. We are living in a time where a way of life is presented to us as the answer to our struggles and difficulties—a path that easily leads to rely on material things and wealth as the source of our happiness and fulfillment. At the same time, our lives continue to be assaulted by events that are out of our control and by situations and decisions that weary us and cause us suffering and a loss of hope. On the world and national scene, we are confronted with suffering and death all around us, in Ukraine and Gaza and now Lebanon, where bombings kill the innocent every day; in all parts of our own country, where innocent adults and students become the victims of someone's rage and fear permeates our daily living, when we walk the city streets or even send our children off to school. And every time we ask the question: why. Even in our personal lives we so often ask that same question—why is this happening to me? Why is someone I love suffering so much? Especially during and after Covid—what is my life all about and where am I going with it? The ultimate answer to these questions and the deepest of life's struggles is in faith, Christian faith, which is not really about rules and regulations, do's and don'ts, as Pope Francis has often said, but about an encounter, a meeting with a Person, Jesus Christ.

I have been writing these past weeks about the pilgrimage we are all on and I have invited you to see life as a journey. Today I invite you to consider one path on that journey, a path and journey to meet that Person, a journey to deepen faith and to discover who this Jesus is and what a difference He can make in your life. When we mature as adults, we come to realize that all life is a journey; we never really arrive; we can never say I have come to the perfect spot. The same is true of our faith life. We can never say, "I am finally a Christian." We are always on a journey of faith. We are always on a journey through the events of our lives where we mature to discover and experience the love God has for us, the presence of God in and through all those events, and the very purpose for which God has called us into being and through which He offers us life, and life to the full.

So if you are wondering what is happening in your life, if you are seeking a path that will help you to discover the meaning of your life, if you have often desired to really encounter Christ in the reality of your life, then I invite you to this **Catechesis** which begins **Monday night, September 30th at 8:00PM in the Parish Center, and continues every Monday and Thursday evening.** The **Catechesis** is an experience of the significance of what it means to be a Christian in today's times. These are not just

lectures but an opportunity to experience the Good News of Jesus Christ as directly relevant to our lives. Everyone is welcome—those with faith, those who question their faith and those without faith, those baptized and those who have not been baptized, those who may have left the Church, those who may have wondered if this is the time to return.

I invite and encourage you to come and listen. Maybe there is someone you know, whom God has placed in your life specifically for you to invite **them** to come and listen. Maybe this is the time, to speak a word, to invite them, and bring them, and listen with them, to grow in an adult experience of your faith and rediscover the joy of knowing Jesus Christ, and in Him, to find peace in the midst of your doubts and struggles, and fulfillment in your joys. **COME AND LISTEN.**

1. Numbers 11:25-29

Like the **Book of Exodus**, the narratives in this book are punctuated by accounts of rebellion on the part of the Chosen People as they journey toward the Promised Land. The people complain repeatedly about the difficulties of the journey. Moses, in turn, complains to God that he cannot shoulder this great responsibility and God intervenes, bestowing the same spirit on seventy chosen members of the community. In this excerpt God makes it clear that no matter what the manner in which He chooses to confer this spirit, it is He Who ultimately is the giver and in a way He chooses.

2. James 5:1-6

Provoked by some disparity in the community, James, in strong and even scathing language, denounces those Christians who have put their trust in riches. Since, traditionally, the main sources (and signs) of wealth were seen to be crops, garments and gold and silver, these ill-gotten goods will all meet destruction, along with their owners. Special condemnation is reserved for those who cheat their workers. The cries of these laborers for justice will not go unheard.

3. Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

This passage continues last week's reflection on authority within the community of believers. Someone outside the group is working miracles in Jesus' name and the disciples object, not because of their concern for Jesus but for their own authority. Once again, Jesus rebukes them. The disciples, for all the wrong reasons, want discipleship defined narrowly. Jesus, for all the right reasons, defines it broadly. Then Jesus adds a further warning. Those who consciously become stumbling blocks for those of faith are destined for Gehenna, a valley south of Jerusalem used to burn garbage and the symbol for condemnation.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Like Joshua in the 1st Reading, am I jealous of the gifts that others seem to have (not wealth, but spiritual gifts, e.g. love, compassion, generosity)?
2. Is the 2nd Reading, concerning possessions, luxury, justice, etc., addressed to me in any way? Think hard.
3. Am I the cause for anyone stumbling spiritually? Children? Spouse? Co-workers? Neighbors? How?
