SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

As I mentioned in my column in the bulletin of Sept. 11th, “there are a host of things clogging the calendar.” And there still are. This weekend, there will be another invitation, with an accompanying video (how lucky you are—I’m not in this one). As Covid has receded, the pace of our lives has picked up, even if it has not returned completely to pre-Covid levels. But more than any of these, the spirit (our spirit) needs time to experience anew the presence of the Lord Jesus in all of this, not so much in silence but through the eyes of faith of other travelers along the way. Come and hear John offer a discipleship that helps us face all of these, and face them with a new hope, a new encouragement, a new enthusiasm and a new vision. By the time you read this, we will have held the first of our "House Gatherings," and I will report on it in my next column. The House Gatherings are opportunities to **reconnect** as a parish after the long disruption caused by Covid 19, a chance to see "old" friends and meet new ones, a chance to socialize and to pray together, a chance to grow closer to one another as a community of faith. In the early church it was this community of faith that sustained the faith of the individuals and gave them the strength to call others to believe as well, even in the face of opposition and oppression from the power of the state. While such public oppression doesn't exist today, opposition certainly does and gathering together "in communion of faith" offers that same support to continue on our journey, even in the face of the world's opposition and indifference. TODAY'S READINGS

1. Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2: 2-4

The prophet is dismayed at God's lack of response to the suffering of the nation under Chaldean (Babylonian) oppression. Recognizing that Judah's survival as a nation is threatened, the prophet wonders why God does not intervene to protect His people. God responds and directs the prophet to write every word—people who embrace heavenly values and seek the things of God will prevail, though no timetable for this deliverance is set. The reader must have faith, trusting in the promise.

2. 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14

Gifted with grace and faith, believers, such as Timothy, are to tend these gifts as one would the embers of a fire. For the fire to be maintained, it must be stirred and fanned. For believers, this occurs when they accept the hardships imposed by the persecutions of the times, through which their faith is deepened and strengthened. But they are not alone; God is with them in the struggle. As an example, Paul points to his own life as he was paying the ultimate cost for his faith in Jesus.

3. Luke 17: 5-10

Faith is not a matter of quantity, Jesus tells his wavering disciples (on the subject of forgiveness). Faith involves trust, relationship and commitment. Even the tiniest amount of faith is overwhelmingly powerful. More is not needed; trusting enough to put it into practice will be sufficient. The parable that follows teaches that discipleship is a constant, never-ending service about which one can never do more than is expected.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. How do I view the world in which I live? Is God easy to find in my worldview?
2. What are some challenges I currently face that call me to greater faith?
3. What people do I know who have worked "miracles" in the lives of those around them because of their faith in Jesus? How?

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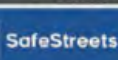


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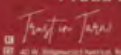


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
