Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

A week ago this past Friday, Sept. 30th, we held the first of our House Gatherings. Just to refresh your memories about the history of this initiative. They were first envisioned to be held within six months of coming out of the “lockdown,” when the church was closed for three months. These gatherings were to be the first attempts to reconnect with one another after that lockdown. Then Delta struck and it was thought it would not be prudent to gather people in so intimate a setting. So we put them off until the following year. And Omicron struck and it was just as imprudent then as it would have been with Delta. Finally in this Fall of 2022, two years after the initial planned initiative, it was decided to go ahead with the project.

It’s really very simple. Gather people together in homes in various parts of the parish. The format is equally simple, socializing, prayer and sharing. From my perspective, it was a success. Everyone who registered came, and then some. It was, at it were, a full house. People mingled, reintroduced each other, and met new people, some who were even brand new to the parish. The whole event was over in two hours, although the hosts graciously invited all to stay as long as they wished. While it may not have been exciting, like a Ridgewood football game, it was a pleasant time, relaxed and enjoyable. No hard sell of anything. No arm twisting. Just friends getting to be with friends.

There are five such House Gatherings left on the schedule between now and the beginning of November. I encourage as many as possible to look into being part of this “reconnecting.” They are for anyone who belongs to the parish. Just because they’re being held physically in Ridgewood, all parishioners, whether from Ridgewood or Paramus or Glen Rock, or wherever, are invited to attend. We know that we go beyond the physical boundaries of Ridgewood, so please be a part of this “family gathering.” You can register by going to the homepage of the website or scanning the QR code which appears elsewhere in this bulletin or calling the rectory. That number and extension also appears elsewhere in this bulletin. I think you’ll have a really enjoyable and rewarding evening as you contribute your little bit of “recovery” to our parish life.

There is, I think, something big on the horizon for the parish. It’s called **Discipleship Day**, and don’t let the words scare you off. We’ve all been disciples of Jesus Christ, praying to him, walking in his footsteps, doing our part to witness to him in our world. But you and I know our world is getting to be a tough place to navigate, with all of the pressures that exist in our society. I think you know what I mean and if not, check out my column in last week’s bulletin. Well, discipleship is meant not only to help us navigate this world, it’s also meant to help us influence the world for the better. Maybe not the “globe,” but at least the world in which we operate, our small corner of this globe. But that takes a dynamic effort, not herculean, but dynamic. And we all can do it. We all can be that **dynamic disciple**.

And a parish of dynamic disciples not only supports one another—it does **touch the world**. John Poitevent, from Parish Catalyst will help us find the secrets of dynamic discipleship. We all know what a catalyst is—an agent that provokes or speeds significant change or action. Even before the pandemic, you probably noticed the realities of the Church in this 21st century, most especially reduced numbers of young people, especially those in their twenties and thirties, at Mass on Sundays. And that's the surface expression of a deeper distancing of these two generations, Millennials and Gen Z, from the life of faith. Parish Catalyst seeks to reverse that trend and John will try to help us understand what needs to be done to walk down that road. If you're parents of someone in these generations, or if you yourself belong to one of them, come and hear an exciting, encouraging and enlightening path forward for our parish and for the Church. Saturday, October 22nd. Please register, either on-line or through the rectory because lunch will be provided and we need to get an accurate count.

I guess that's it for now. Hopefully the weather will be a little better this week and you can get some time to enjoy fall's changing colors.

As a point of comparison, total church support for the month of September, 2021, was \$97,543 and for September, 2020, it was \$93,391. For September, 2019, pre-pandemic, it was \$113,382. Using electronic giving, **WeShare** is a steady way to support the parish in these recovery times.

TODAY'S READINGS

1. 2 Kings 5:14-17

Naaman, the foreigner, comes to an Israelite prophet for a cure for his leprosy. He and the pagan king who sent him believe in Elisha's power, in contrast to the king of Israel who does not believe. In the part of the story not in this excerpt, Naaman must let go of his pride and rely on God's word to him, through the prophet. When he goes, he is healed. In gratitude, he gathers up sacks of earth from the land of his healing that he may continue to worship the God Whose power made it possible.

2. 2 Timothy 2:8-13

In this excerpt, the reader finds another of the Christological hymns that are to be found in the letters of St. Paul, celebrating Jesus as the source of human hope. In the four if/then statements, the reader is encouraged to persevere, as Paul himself, does, in the struggle, knowing Jesus will be faithful, even to those who are the weakest among them. With this thought to lend them comfort and strength, believers are encouraged to fight the good fight.

3. Luke 17:11-19

Desiring an end to their suffering and to their status as outcasts, these lepers turn to Jesus, to His power and to His compassion. While following Jesus' instructions, one realizes that he has been cured, and also recognizes Who has healed him and the power of God at work in the cure. He returns to give thanks and praise. Jesus is disappointed that only the foreigner has the insight to recognize the cure and to return in gratitude. The outsider and foreigner has become an insider. And he has received healing and salvation.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have you ever been healed, physically, spiritually or emotionally, and thought of it merely as "good luck?" If you recognized it as a blessing, do you give thanks to God?
2. How can you become more conscious of the many ways, great and small, that you experience healing every day?
3. Are you as open to "strangers" and "foreigners" as Elisha and Jesus?
