SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Carlo Acutis was an English born Italian Catholic youth and website designer who is best known for documenting Eucharistic miracles and the approved Marian apparitions around the world and cataloging them onto a website which he created before his death from leukemia at age 15.

He used his passion for the internet to spread his love of the Holy Eucharist. For him, the Holy Eucharist is a highway to heaven. His life plan was to be close to Jesus. To be with Jesus, for Jesus and in Jesus. He believed that our goal is the infinite, not what is finite. Our infinity is our home land. We are expected in heaven since time immemorial. The only thing we have to ask God in prayer is to be holy.

Blessed Carlo Acutis offered his suffering for the church and for the pope. Carlos' death showed that one's faith can change the world. He is a great example for the youth of today.

1. **Isaiah 45:1, 4-6**

History records Cyrus as the founder of the Persian Empire when he toppled the last of the Babylonian kings. But Isaiah regards Cyrus as the “anointed” of the Lord who, whether he knew it or not, whether he acknowledged it or not, accomplished all that he had in accord with God’s saving plan for Israel. It was the God of Israel who took the Persian monarch by the hand and guided his policies, policies that were tolerant, nurturing and benevolent. For its part, Israel, once rebellious and prideful, had become wiser through exile and was now prepared to offer humble service to God and Cyrus was to be the instrument of their freedom to do so.

2. **1 Thessalonians 1:1-5**

Established in the port city of Thessalonica, the seat of Roman government in Macedonia and a melting pot of commerce and cultures, the Christian community was a thriving reality, founded by Paul, Silvanus and Timothy. Recognizing the vibrancy of their life together, Paul encourages them to continue to develop the virtues which bind them together, their faith, love and hope, creating a community worthy of welcoming Christ’s return.

3. **Matthew 22:15-21**

Once again, Matthew relates a controversy story in which Jesus’ enemies attempt to trap Him. Feigning great respect and confidence in Jesus as a teacher, their real motive is to get Him into a no-win situation, paying the tax would offend the Jews, non-paying could be treasonous. Having produced the coin, with the hated foreign image, The Pharisees now have the ball back in their court. In His answer, Jesus challenges them to explain what belongs to God and what to Caesar. In the following verse (omitted from the excerpt), the Pharisees recognize they are losers and go away.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Have you ever experienced God working in unexpected ways or through unlikely agents?
2. Think of a time when you found yourself saying something you didn’t believe. How did you handle your own hypocrisy? Did you learn any lesson from the experience?
3. Jesus would seem to endorse the “separation of church and state.” Is it always that simple and clear cut?
