Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

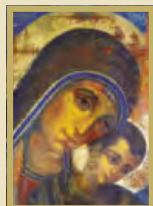

TODAY'S READINGS

1. Wisdom 11:22-12:2

The author of Wisdom was convinced that creation can be the gateway to God and that it is a reflection of God's wisdom. Today's excerpt begins with an affirmation of God's greatness, in comparison to which the entire universe is little more than a grain of sand. And yet, God's love for all that exists is the guiding principle of divine justice. This "lover of souls" (a new title for God) is intent on calling sinful humankind away from wickedness to faith and the rewards that only God can give.

2. 2 Thessalonians 1:11-2:2

Paul prays for this community, that God may make the members of this community worthy of their calling, acknowledging that everything is grace, lovingly bestowed from God the Father and the Lord Jesus. If their dedication to Jesus and the church was faithful, they will be brought to the same glory that they brought to God. This energy by which they bring glory to God should not be disturbed by worries about the coming of the end time. Rather they should remain at peace in the Lord.

3. Luke 19:1-10

In a story unique to Luke, we encounter the figure of Zacchaeus, a chief tax collector who was wealthy and short. And he acts in a way no adult would (running in public and climbing a tree), facing ridicule to see (with his heart, in believing, as well as his eyes), Jesus. Instead, Jesus sees him, and invites Himself to his house (heart). Now Zacchaeus can really see (grasp) Jesus for Who He is and his response is repentance and conversion and reconciliation with God and neighbor.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Has God ever entered your life at a time and in a way you didn't expect? Did you recognize it? What was your response?
2. What stirs in you an appreciation of God's love for you? What diminishes it?
3. Zacchaeus made a fool out of himself just to see Jesus. To what lengths are you willing to go to "see who Jesus is"?
