Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

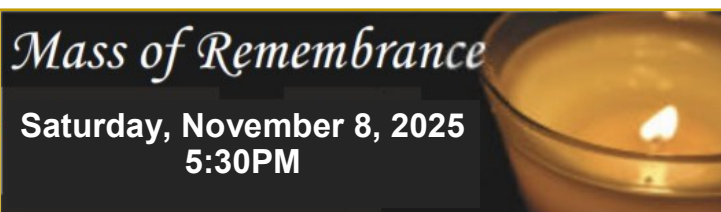

**National Vocation Awareness Week
November 2-8, 2025**

The annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education.

ALL SOULS' DAY



TODAY'S READINGS

There are numerous texts for today's celebration the choice of which is left to the presider who may not have chosen these exact readings.

1. Wisdom 3:1-9

Though attributed to wise King Solomon, this book more properly dates between 60 and 40 B.C. In the opening chapters, the author exposes the weakness of seeking fulfillment in the things of this world alone. Traditionally, the lot of all beyond the grave was the same: all were committed to an ethereal existence apart from God. Reward was experienced in this world, long life, large family riches and prestige. But this is foolishness. The reward of a good life is life with God. The just rest in the hands of God, who created them for immortality. Because of their adherence to virtue, God will accept them as a sacrificial offering.

2. Romans 6:3-9

The baptismal rite (immersion of the whole body into water) symbolically represents the death, burial and resurrection of Christ, the convert descending into the baptismal bath, being covered with its waters and emerging to a new life. As a result, the Christian in this life lives in union with the Risen Christ. This Resurrection of Christ has brought Him into the sphere of "glory" and this Resurrection was not just to publicize His good news, nor to confirm His messianic identity, but to introduce believers into a new mode of life, both here and hereafter.

3. John 6:37-40

In today's excerpt, taken from the *Bread of Life* discourse, Jesus focuses on the reason for His coming, to do the will of the Father. And what is that will—that those who believe may be safe in the Father's Kingdom, not just as a present reality, but also for all eternity in the final resurrection. This is a concept and a promise the Evangelist never departs from, the final eschatology of an eternal Kingdom made available to His disciples by Jesus' own death and Resurrection.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. How do you get lost? What helps you "get found?"
2. If all that is necessary for eternal life is to see Jesus and believe in Him, how much effort do you put into keeping Him in focus?
3. What does the promise of eternal life mean to you on a day-to-day basis?
