

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

1. Malachi 1:14 – 2:2, 8-10

Malachi is the final prophet of the Old Testament. The Temple has been rebuilt and the priesthood and the liturgy re-established. But there has been no interior renewal. The prophet appeals for a sincere faith while the people make excuses for their failures. In a series of question and answer exchanges the people are reminded that God alone is King, that they must respect God's Name and that there is a special bond between the people and God. In this excerpted reading, the prophet also points out the failures of the Levitical priesthood: they do not respect the Levitical covenant, they teach falsehood and they display partiality.

2. 1 Thessalonians 2:7-9, 14

Defending himself from those he called false teachers, Paul affirms the importance of preaching the Gospel with our lips as well as our lives. In comparing himself to a nursing mother, Paul calls upon the universal experience of being loved, not by a caretaker, but by someone who gives us life and is never far away. So it is with the bonds Paul formed with the community in Thessalonica whom he introduced to Christ. Paul, and his companions, overflow with gratitude to God because this community is so receptive to God's word.

3. Matthew 23:1-12

Scholars debate whether the harshness of this controversy is more reflective of the situation of the Church in Matthew's time, rather than the actual relationship between Jesus and the Jewish leadership. Whatever the reality may be, the point is the same, authentic leadership practices what it preaches. Jewish leadership had passed on to the people obligations and observances that were originally intended only for them (the heavy burdens). In addition, these leaders had become ostentatious and self-aggrandizing, seeking honors, titles and status, filled with pride and arrogance.

2. Has your presence in the life of someone else truly been a blessing for them?
3. Are you willing to help others even when you know they won't thank you?
