SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May)
Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



TODAY'S READINGS

1. 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14

The two books of Maccabees recount the happenings during the Jewish revolt against the Seleucid kings, led by the family for whom the books are named. The first book recounts their military successes and the second book recounts not only the same, but also inspiring accounts of ordinary people who remained faithful in the face of death. Today's excerpt is an abbreviated account of one such family, a mother and her seven sons. Though we meet only three of the brothers in this excerpt, all seven, and their mother, express their deep faith in the God of Israel, noting that the limited power of the king will, in the end, be no match for the immeasurable power of God. In this reading, we are also introduced to the beginnings of belief in an after-life, where faithfulness and up-rightness are rewarded.

2. 2 Thessalonians 2:16 – 3:5

Having sought to calm the excitement of believers in this community that the end (the coming of Jesus) was near, Paul exhorts them, instead, to pray that Jesus, and the Father, give them courage and strength to persevere, that the Gospel be spread throughout the world and that all (missionaries) who spread it be protected in their labors.

3. Luke 20:27-38

Jesus is drawn into an intra-Jewish dispute between two leading movements within Judaism, the Sadducees (the priestly segment associated with Temple leadership) and the Pharisees (those who accepted teaching beyond the Pentateuch). While their case is an absurd extension of the levirate law (marriage law intended to protect a deceased man's name, widow and progeny), Jesus' response focuses on the real meaning of resurrection, not an extension as life as we know it, but a totally new kind of life given by God, the previous being a quantitative extension of earthly life, the latter being qualitatively different. From a Christian perspective, this passage bears witness to the teaching of the resurrection as gift of radical new life, bestowed only by God and radically transforming those who receive it.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Does the thought of everlasting life have a conscious effect on your daily living? Does it cause you to live every day in hopefulness?
2. Do you live as if your life has eternal consequences?
3. With whom can you share Christ's promise of eternal life?

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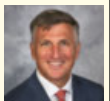
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
