Communal Baptisms are held every month on the first Sunday at 1:30pm and on the third Saturday at 11:00am (with some exceptions). Register a month or two in advance for the Baptismal Program.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confessions)

Saturday 1:00pm-2:00pm & Monday 7:00pm-7:30pm (Sept-May) Other times by pre-arranged appt. with a priest. Communal Penance celebrations (with individual confessions) are celebrated in Advent and Lent and will be announced.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Those who wish to enter the Catholic faith and Catholics who wish to complete the sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation are most welcome to begin the journey at any time. Call the Rectory.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners regularly practicing the Faith at our Parish are welcomed to contact the Rectory one year in advance of a proposed wedding date. Specific dates are only discussed after meeting with a Priest. Couples must attend a pre-Cana program and provide required Sacramental and other documentation.

Dear Friends,

I'm so happy to be home. My vacation was good, not great, because of some weather issues but it was restful, relaxing and stress-free. But, as I've said, because it came one day after my trip to the Turks and Caicos Islands to celebrate Confirmation, it really seemed like a long absence from the parish. The priests told me how smoothly the parish ran without me so the natural conclusion is that I should take more vacations. They didn't like that conclusion.

Enough said about my vacation. I want to share with you some thoughts on my trip to the *Mission*. This was the first time I had been there since 2019. I was scheduled to go in the spring of 2020 but Covid came instead. Then I was scheduled to go down for the school graduation last June but something came up here and I had to cancel that trip at the last minute. So it has been more than four and a half years since I made personal visit.

It's amazing how much can happen and change in that short a time. The school, **Holy Family Academy**, continues to expand, now going from 1st grade to graduation from high school in the 11th grade (they use the British system). This year they entered a new relationship with St. Thomas University where the 12th year becomes a continuation of high school as well as the first year of college, in a unique combining of virtual and in-person learning, where the professors from St. Thomas actually come to the Island for two weeks of in-person instruction. The parish is looking to build a separate high school building on the parish campus, allowing the Academy to grow even bigger. In addition, the parish had built, and is now adding onto, a residence for some of the faculty who teach in the school.

The life of the parish also continues to grow. Cardinal Tobin celebrated Confirmation back in January and I celebrated it only 9 months later. There was a time when we were celebrating Confirmation only every other year because there were so few candidates. Now, twice in one year. A sure sign of growth. An interesting aside. One of the priests ordained this past May is from the Island and I confirmed him a number of years ago. On my most recent visit, I now confirmed his sister.

This January 1st will be the 25th anniversary of the transfer of the Mission from the Diocese of Nassau, in the Bahamas, to the Archdiocese of Newark. I will be the only religious, cleric, who was involved in that transfer and is still involved today. While the growth may not match the growth of the bitcoin business, it has been slow but steady and will surely be more long lasting. I am grateful to the Lord to have been a small part of it. As has Mount Carmel. Just check out the plaque in the front lobby.

Just a reminder. Next weekend will be the solicitation for the **Annual Fund for the Academy of Our Lady**, our own parochial school. This year it was separate from the Academy Weekend so we could focus on the value of the

school. As **Holy Family Academy** has been invaluable to the mission of the Church in TCI, so The Academy of Our Lady is an invaluable part of our mission as a parish. Each year, I ask all our parish households to help us keep the school vibrant and effective as a place for Catholic formation and evangelization. Please be one of those households who support our school by making a pledge of \$100 (or more). Envelopes are in the pews and you may either fill one out and drop it in the boxes at the doors of the church, drop it at the rectory, or mail it directly to the school.

Your generosity and support is greatly appreciated.

In less than two weeks, we will celebrate Thanksgiving, the quintessential American holiday. However you're accustomed to celebrate it, why not begin the day with a true act of thanksgiving to God "from Whom all blessings flow?" Join us for the special liturgy we celebrate at 8:30AM that morning and take home some blessed bread to break with those you have around your own thanksgiving table. From **our table** to your table, the gift of the Lord's kindness and generosity. What a great beginning of a great day.

1. Wisdom 6:12-16

Written in Greek, the Book of Wisdom had its origin among Jews living outside Israel. Influenced by Hellenism, the book personifies Wisdom as a feminine figure who acts in concert with God at creation. In the excerpted passage, the author urges the reader to seek wisdom above all else. Wisdom is a gift from God and can readily be found by those who seek her. People need only to look.

2. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

Attempting to ease the worries of the community about those who have died before the 2nd coming of Christ, Paul assures them that the bleak view of the pagan world is not the truth. With Christ's return, there will also come the resurrection of those who have fallen asleep. Paul draws on familiar apocalyptic images to create a picture of Jesus' return, images which some now take literally, but were not meant to be so.

3. Matthew 25:1-13

This parable has one lesson—to encourage vigilance at the delay of the second coming of the Christ. The deciding factor of the story regarding which virgins are wise and which are foolish centers around oil needed for the lamps, and those who had the forethought to bring sufficient amount. Allegorically, the oil stands for good works, an important theme in Matthew. Those without oil (good works) can try all they want to make up for their unpreparedness, but it is too late. Since no one knows the day or the hour, everyone must be prepared.
