What an incredible array of talent was on display that evening and what an extraordinary gift of that talent to the parish community. Not to take away from any other group, for me, it was the Children's Choir who made my night. But thank you to all, and to the leaders and directors for all you do for the Music Ministry here at OLMC, not just on that night but for adding to the praise and worship we give to the Lord in our weekly liturgies every week. We are grateful.

I want to remind everyone again about the possibilities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If you're reading this online, the three opportunities for confession are still available, Saturday (12/17) from 1:00PM-2:00PM; Monday (12/19) from 7:00PM-8:00PM and the Parish Penance Service, with Scripture, Song, and individual confession, Wednesday (12/21) at 7:30 PM. If you're reading this in hardcopy, only Monday and Wednesday are still available. **No confessions will be heard Saturday, Christmas Eve, 12/24.** The lessening of the pandemic and the opening of a new door for the New Year is a great time to sweep away the old, and begin fresh for the new life that awaits us in the New Year. Take advantage of these opportunities and come.

I just want to say a final word on the Christmas celebration. Christmas, in its **original** and religious sense, is the remembering of God's tremendous love for his creation, especially that part of it we call—humankind. Made in God's image and likeness, humankind drifted away from God's original design and sinned. The Christ-event is God's special **GRACE** in not only calling us back, but showing us how to get back and giving us **Himself**, as the way to get back, in the God-man, Jesus Christ, who now walks with us, individually, each and every one of us, and communally, as his church. The beginning of this Christ-event is celebrated in the **Nativity—Christmas**. Like all beginnings, it starts with hope, joy, dreams of a better tomorrow. Even with the social trappings that surround it, the **Christmas** celebration begins and ends with the remembering of that **Nativity**. During and even after (if we

can say after) the pandemic, many have substituted other ways of celebrating and remembering this **Nativity**, including livestreaming. This year, if you are physically able, come back to the in-person celebration of the beginning of your journey with your God. Let us join together as His special community to celebrate His love and to experience again the bond of faith that makes His people one. We have so many celebrations, liturgies, precisely to allow His people to praise and thank Him for the gift of divine life in His Son. Let this be the moment to place your trust in Him, to be filled with the dreams and visions of a better tomorrow and to sing His praise in the company of all who believe that this God is to be loved, celebrated and worshipped. Please join us either Saturday afternoon/evening or Sunday. And make this the beginning of a whole new life with God. By the way, if the celebrations at 4:00 and 5:30 in the church are full, please walk over to the auditorium where the celebrations will be just as warm and joyful.

NO 6:30PM MASS CHRISTMAS DAY

1. Isaiah 7:10-14

In this reading, the prophet confronts the pride of the royal house. King Ahaz seeks a way to secure the city against a powerful Assyria. The Northern Kingdom, Israel, has already entered into an alliance with Syria and now they seek to persuade Judah, under Ahaz' rule, to join with them. Ahaz is asked to seek a sign from the Lord but, with a dishonest humility that hides his pride, he prefers to place more trust in his own plans. Isaiah announces that the king will get the sign that he doesn't want, but instead of being a sign of deliverance, it will be a sign of his failure.

2. Romans 1:1-7

Paul introduces himself to a community he did not found. He writes to the Greek-speaking immigrants for whose benefit he believes he had been set apart, so that the good news of God's universal love would be made known. What will follow will be a summation of Paul's understanding of the Gospel, its message, its purpose and its consequences. But this excerpt today is the introduction in which Paul identifies himself as slave and apostle, and Jesus as Son, Who died and rose to call everyone to faith, obedience and holiness.

3. Matthew 1:18-24

Ever the knowledgeable Jew, Matthew uses the prophecy of Isaiah to introduce his readers to the "birth announcement" of Jesus, the Christ. Jesus is the Immanu-El, the God-With-Us. Regardless of whom Isaiah might have meant, Matthew understands Jesus to be the ultimate fulfillment, the Davidic decendency fulfilled by legal adoption by Joseph, who puts aside his concern about Mary's pregnancy after the angelic appearance in his dream. In assuming the responsibility for naming the child, Joseph exercises a father's legal responsibility, assuring the fulfillment of the Isaiah prophecy.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. God promised Immanuel, God-With-Us. Has God been with you and your family during the pandemic? Is God with you today?
2. Because of his response, Joseph becomes the "father" (in a spiritual sense) of Jesus. How are you a spiritual parent to those around you?
3. God surprised Joseph who, nevertheless, said yes, even in his own confusion. What about you? When surprised by God, do you say yes, even in your confusion?
