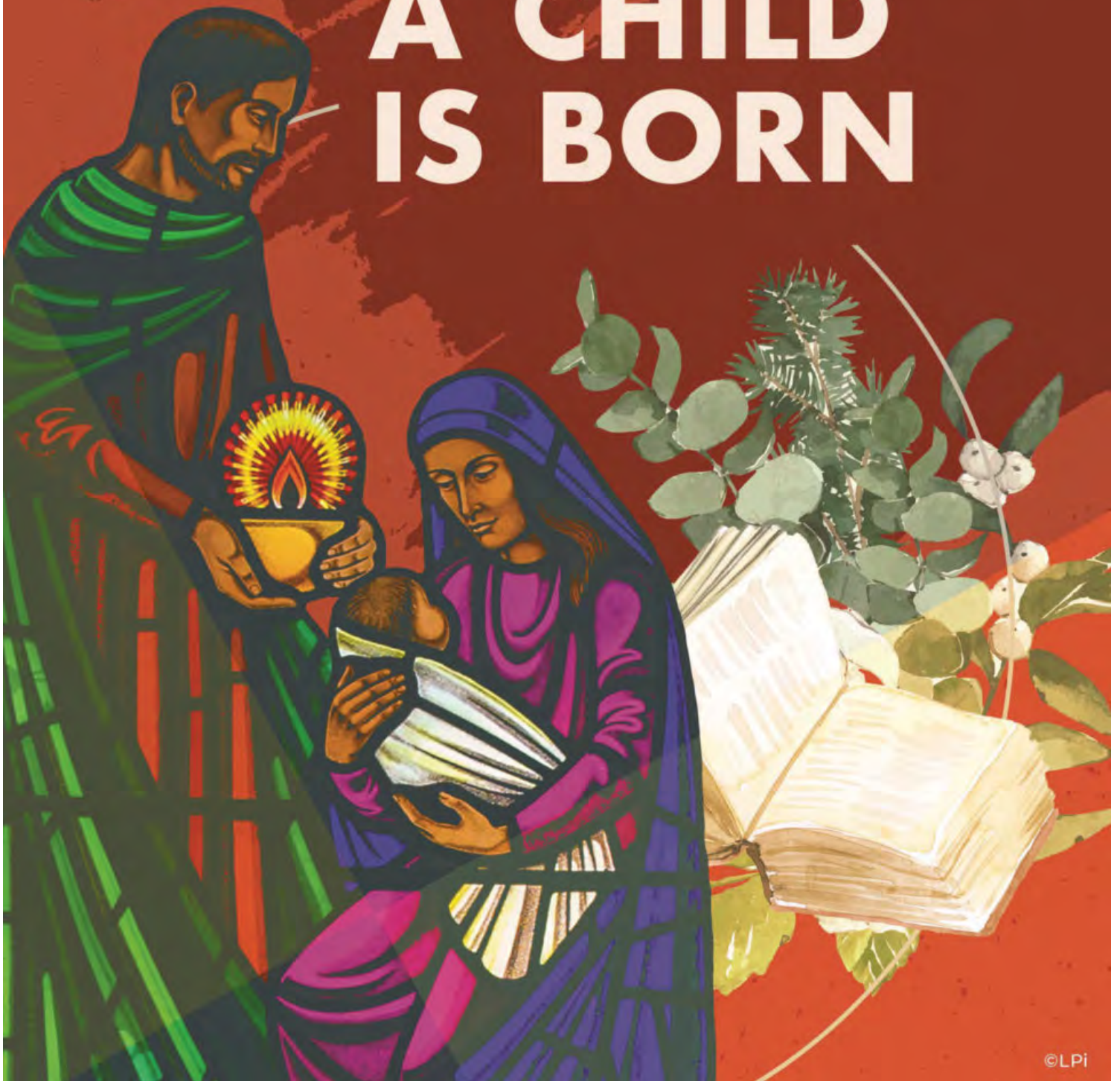

Dear Friends,

O Come, O Come Emmanuel.” The premier hymn of the Advent season. We are most familiar with the refrain, which continues, “*Rejoice! Rejoice! O Israel, To Thee Shall Come Emmanuel.*” **Emmanuel—God With Us.** As we celebrate Christmas today, we affirm—**God Is With Us.**

One of the deeply reflective moments in the preparation to this day has been the daily **Alleluia Verse**, the short line that is said (sung on Sundays, preceded and followed by ALLELUIA) before the Gospel reading. In these verses, the Church sums up the yearnings of our hearts as we prepare to welcome the most generous gift that can ever be given—**the gift of God, Himself, in the form of the Child Jesus.** These verses form some of the verses of that popular hymn and they began on the 17th and continued every day until the 23rd. They are called the *O Antiphons*, because they were originally (and still) sung as part of Vespers, the Evening Prayer of the Church. The verse appears in italic, the plain print is my commentary.

O WISDOM of our God Most High, guiding creation with power and love: come to teach us the path of knowledge. With so many voices clamoring for our attention, seeking to direct our lives, who better than God to claim that distinction?

O SACRED LORD OF THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL, giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai: come, stretch out your mighty hand to set us free. In our day and age, we are beset with all sorts of worries and anxieties, personally, culturally, nationally. Who can free us from the demons that eat away at our hope?

O FLOWER OF JESSE'S STEM, Sign of God's love for all his people: come to save us without delay. In our world of struggle, pain and suffering, both that we cause and that we have no control over, God wants us to know that we don't have to “go it alone” because Jesus, the sign of God's love for us, is always with us. We are never alone or without love in our lives.

O KEY OF DAVID, opening the gates of God's eternal kingdom: come, break down the prison walls of death and lead your captive people into freedom. St. Paul says death is the last enemy to be defeated. Believe with all your heart that those you love and have gone before you truly live in the Kingdom of God, of justice, light and peace, the Kingdom lit by the glory of God. And they are in peace. Believe it and be consoled.

O RADIANT DAWN, splendor of eternal light, sun of justice: come, shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death. Our hearts are so often weighed down by so much we have to bear, disappointments, sickness, despair, broken relationships, the return of the pandemic, or another one. The Lord comes to shine on us, warming and refreshing us, lifting us, carrying us.

O KING OF ALL THE NATIONS, the only joy of every human heart. Our hearts yearn for so much, for so many things, relationships, material possessions, security, comfort. Yet St. Augustine reminds us “our hearts are restless until they rest in Thee.”

O KEYSTONE of the mighty arch of man, come and save the creatures you fashioned from the dust. The God who created us would not let us slip from His hands. When we find our joy, our hope, our fulfillment in living in His love, He can build for us here an earthly city of goodness and right.

O EMMANUEL, king and lawgiver, desire of the nations, Savior of all people: come and set us free, Lord our God. What is the hope of your heart this Christmas? Christ is the only answer. And with Him, all else fits together.

The Church ends the **O ANTIPHONES** where it starts—**EMMANUEL—GOD WITH US**. What else is necessary!

To you and yours, **GOD WITH YOU, today and every day!**

1. Isaiah 9:1-6

Children have great significance in Isaiah. The book begins with God looking for the children of Israel. In oracles like this one, the prophet looks forward to the birth of a child in the royal line of David who would be worthy of David's throne, unlike the kings Isaiah knew. The titles bestowed on him testify to his special relationship with God. With the birth of this new king, not only the darkness of Israel, but the darkness of the whole world will be removed and all people can enjoy the light of faith.

2. Titus 2:11-14

Paul sees the first appearance of the Son of God as the enfleshment of God's grace. He came to save us and teach us how to live. With such help, we have every reason to look forward to His final appearance. This is our hope, a hope that cannot be thwarted by any hostile force.

3. Luke 2:1-14

The first announcement of the birth of the Messiah is not exactly what we would have expected. The birth is described as simply another baby being born to a rural couple as had happened many times before. There are no dispatches sent to kings, governors, important people. The announcement is sent to shepherds. He is not found in a palace, surrounded by the important. He is found in a manger, wrapped in the clothes of the poor, and the only praise of recognition comes from the heavenly host. And the heat of His message—peace and favor from the Lord.

REFLECTIONS FOR THE WEEK

1. Where in my life have I been in darkness? Where in my world, both personal and communitarian, do I still encounter darkness?
2. Have I passed from the darkness of the pandemic to a new light? Has Christ helped me in this?
3. Does the very circumstance of Jesus' birth speak to me about what I hold important?

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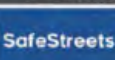


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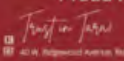


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
